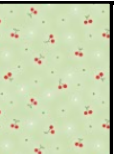
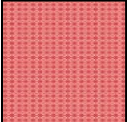

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric

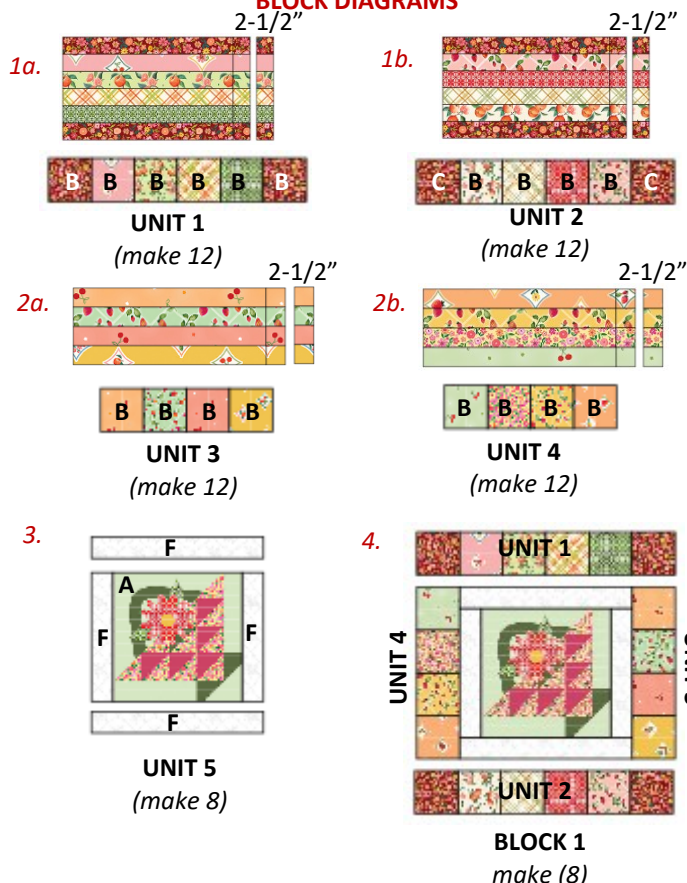
*Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to **BLOCK DIAGRAMS**

- Sew (4) **B** 2-1/2" x WOF strips and (2) **In Bloom Red** 2-1/2" x WOF strips together on long sides, with **In Bloom** strips on the outside. Make (1) strip set. Crosscut (12) 2-1/2" wide units to make **UNIT 1**. In the same manner, sew (4) **B** 2-1/2" x WOF strips and (2) **C** 2-1/2" x WOF strips together on long sides. Make (1) strip set. Crosscut (12) 2-1/2" wide units to make **UNIT 2**.
- Sew (4) **B** 2-1/2" x WOF strips together on long sides. Make (1) strip set. Crosscut (12) 2-1/2" wide units to make **UNIT 3**. In the same manner, sew (4) **B** 2-1/2" x WOF strips together on long sides. Make (1) strip set. Crosscut (12) 2-1/2" wide units to make **UNIT 4**.
- Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **A** 6-1/2" square, then sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to top and bottom to make (1) **UNIT 5**. Make (8).
- Sew (1) **UNIT 3** and (1) **UNIT 4** to sides of (1) **UNIT 5**, then sew (1) **UNIT 1** and (1) **UNIT 2** to top and bottom to make (1) **BLOCK 1**. Square to 12-1/2", make (8).

BLOCK DIAGRAMS

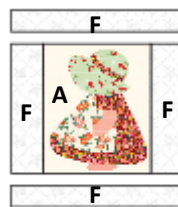


BLOCK ASSEMBLY: *Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS*

5. Sew (1) **F** 2" x 6-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **A** 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle, then sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to top and bottom to make (1) **UNIT 6**. Make (4).
6. Sew (1) **UNIT 3** and (1) **UNIT 4** to sides of (1) **UNIT 6**, then sew (1) **UNIT 1** and (1) **UNIT 2** to top and bottom to make (1) **BLOCK 2**. Square to 12-1/2", make (4).
7. Sew (2) **F** 2" squares and (2) **B** 2" squares together in a four patch to make **BLOCK 3**. Square to 3-1/2", make (4).

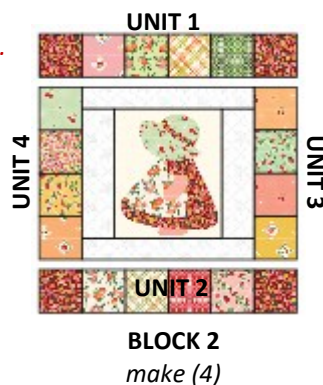

QUILT ASSEMBLY: *Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.*

8. Sew (3) blocks together in a row, with (2) **G** 2" x 12-1/2" strips between blocks. Make (4) BLOCK ROWS.
9. Sew (3) **G** 2" x 12-1/2" strips to (2) **B** 2" squares to make a SASHING ROW. Make (3).
10. Sew BLOCK ROWS together, alternating with SASHING ROWS.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: *Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.*

Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.

11. Sew (1) **D** 2" x (53") strip to each side of quilt center, then sew (1) **D** 2" x (42-1/2") strip to top and bottom.
12. Sew (1) **E** 3-1/2" x (56") strip to each side of quilt.
13. Sew (1) **E** 3-1/2" x (42-1/2") strip to (2) **BLOCK 3** to make (1) **BORDER UNIT**. Make (2). Sew (1) **BORDER UNIT** to top and bottom.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **C** fabric.
