Since then they have poured their heart and soul into updating and refurbishing the villa. They have personalized it with their touch and made it another home. St. John was hit very hard during hurricanes Irma and Maria in 2017 and since "It's About Time" received mostly cosmetic damages, they opened their home and assisted neighbors in need as Rog and Kath had done before. They have completed all the repairs and continue to go there every chance they get and carry on the tradition of sharing the love and admiration of the island with as many people as they can.
