

How to set up up your Online IRS Account:

- 1) Go to [IRS.gov](https://www.irs.gov).
- 2) Select "Sign in to your account".
- 3) Click "New to online account? Get started".
- 4) Click "Sign in to your Online Account".
- 5) Select "Create New Account - ID.me".
- 6) Enter your e-mail and create a password. Click "Remember me" and "I accept". Click "Continue".
- 7) Go to your e-mail. Open the e-mail from ID.me. Click "Confirm your e-mail".
- 8) Return to IRS webpage and choose a multi-factor authentication method, such as Text.
- 9) Enter your phone number for receiving texts.. When you receive the code, enter the six-digit code in the IRS webpage.
- 10) Verify your identity via self-service. You will need your driver's license or passport and a selfie.
- 11) Follow the prompts to upload a photo of your identity document and your selfie.

What is ID.me?

The US Government uses ID.me to manage secure access to your IRS account (and other government websites, including the Social Security Administration).

You have two options for verifying your identity?


- 1) A self-service process that requires a photo of a government ID and selfie, or
- 2) A live call with an ID.me video chat agent that doesn't require biometric data.


Document photo tips

When taking photos of your documents, follow the tips below:


Do take your photo straight on, and not at an angle


Do place your document on a dark surface


Do match the orientation of the document


Do make sure there are no other objects in the photo




Don't crop the corners or edges of your document


Don't cover information


Don't take or submit blurry photos
