- There will be a guest at GBN on Friday during block 8-9. Alumnus Nathan Salstone will be coming in to speak with the students. Nathan is a 2013 graduate of GBN. He went on to study at Carnegie Mellon University and, after graduation, has performed in the Harry Potter show on Broadway in New York.

Julie Ann Hill -

- Congratulations to Erin Rosenfeld for her win (1st place) at the State speech competition. GBN has not taken first place in speech since 1997.

- Contest Play (*Complete Works of Shakespeare, Abridged*) took first place at sectionals and fifth place at state. Three members of the cast made the All-State cast and GBN got the tech award for having the best stage set-up (the wagon).
- Group Interpretation (*Tales from the Hinterland*) came in fourth place in sectionals.
- Winnie the Pooh is the children's play that will be performed later this month. 19 freshmen and sophomore students are involved, which is great!
- There will be no rehearsals on Good Friday (optional for Winnie the Pooh on Good Friday) or Easter.
- Three student directors are working on Winnie the Pooh. They are Allison Wilensky, Evan Denenberg, and Emma Gradman. They are doing a great job.
