# February 5, 2019 Meeting Minutes

# Choir Director Reports Chad Davidson and Julie Ann Hill:

- Techny rehearsals have started. The Techny concerts will be on March 10, 2019, at 2:30 P.M. and 5:00 P.M.
- Chorale and Cecillian choirs will be selling singing Valentines on 2/13/19 (not 2/14 since Kelsey Nichols will be taking Ladies First to sing at a retirement home on 2/14). The money that they earn will go to the charity of choice which is Erika's Lighthouse this year. <a href="https://www.erikaslighthouse.org/">https://www.erikaslighthouse.org/</a>
- Only 6 Show Meals will be needed during spring musical rehearsals (not the 8 that we previously thought). This is because the show rehearsals overlap with a few religious holidays. Kelsey will relay to the Show Meals chairs the dates that meals are needed.
- The trip to Los Angeles was a huge success. The performance at Disney was wonderful. The workshop at USC fell on Martin Luther King Day so the campus was a little quiet but GBN grad, Cameron Glass, heard that the group was on campus and came over to connect with them. The group enjoyed seeing *Wicked* while in L.A. and hiked in the Hollywood Hills. The group walked about 12 miles each day!

- The fall show will be a musical, *Matilda*. Auditions will be in May. 8<sup>th</sup> graders will be invited / encouraged to come audition. The first rehearsals will be in early June (the 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and maybe 12<sup>th</sup>).
- The spring Children's Play at GBN will be *Winnie the Pooh* (April 25-27, 2019). Auditions for this show will happen AFTER the auditions for the musical (*Mamma Mia!*). Student directors will be Evan Denenberg, Alison Wilensky. Emma Gradman will also be working on the show.
- The tickets for *Dear Evan Hansen* are sold out. Julie Ann opened up the sales to teachers and they were bought up enthusiastically.
- Julie Ann may be able to get another round of tickets to *Hamilton*. CTPO members seemed interested in that proposal and would be happy to purchase tickets if they are not bought out completely by the students.
- Group Interp and Contest Play will have performances at night on 3/14 and 3/15 at 7:00 P.M. Sectionals will be at Fremd High School on 3/16/19. There are 6 kids in Contest Play and 12 in Group Interp.
- Students on the Orchesis Dance Team will have an easier time scheduling this year if they want to be in the musical because the dance show was shifted to December.
- There was a question about how the charity of choice is selected and Chad replied that students in Chorale select the charity and the students can propose as many charities as they like. There is a voting process that involves first narrowing down the options to a few finalists and then a final vote is taken and the winner is determined.
- The All-State Musical, *In the Heights*, was great, particularly the performance by GBN student Carly Meyer.
- *Aida* will be the All-State musical next year.
