February 3, 2020

Motion made to accept minutes from last meeting. Motion passed.

Directors' Reports:

Chad Davidson:

- The Peoria Illinois Music Educational Convention was a positive experience. Congratulations to Bella Kim, Zach Torf and David Schaeffer who participated in the all state choir.
- Glenbrook Festival fast approaching. Ticket orders available soon.
- Trip to Spain (Barcelona, Valencia and Madrid) is March 19-27, 2021 during spring break. Proposal from Bright Spark coming under \$3,500. per student.
- Kelsey Nichols returns March 2nd. Mr. Sirvatka will stay through the Glenbrook Festival and will continue to work with Ow! and Fermata.
- Currently there are 24 girls and 7 boys registered for choir from the incoming freshman class. Mr. Davidson has visited all the junior highs to encourage registration.

Julie Ann Hill:

- Looking for additional members for crew during the Variety Show.
- Group Interp is underway. A small number of students turned out due to spring break dates conflict. There are 10 kids instead of 12.
- Incoming freshman activity night resulted in interested kids.
- Mrs. Hill's baby is due at the end of May. She will take 5-10 days off in the spring and the remainder of her maternity leave in the fall.
- Incoming freshman won't be allowed to audition for the fall play.
- Musical audition materials for Cinderella posted on gbnchoir.com and gbntheatre.com . Auditions are February 25 and 26. Callbacks are February 27 and 28.
- 5 projects to look forward to next year:
 - Fall Play- auditions in May, presented Oct. 8,9,10
 - One Acts- auditions in August, presented Sept. 24,25 and 26
 - Winter Play- auditions Oct. 21-23, presented Nov. 19,20,21
 - Spring Children's Play- auditions March 10,11 and 12, presented April 23-25
 - Glenbrook Musical (at GBS)- auditions Feb. 23-26, presented April 28- May1
- **IMPORTANT TO NOTE:** As of right now, the above are the 5 projects kids can participate in. There's a chance a winter showcase will be added, but it will depend on participation numbers in the fall. Also, a big change from this year is that kids can **EITHER** do the Fall Play **OR** One Acts. As usual, kids can **EITHER** do musical **OR** the children's play. The maximum number of projects a kid can do is 3 (plus V-Show which is not technically a theatre production). No Group Interp or Contest Play due to the spring break trip to Spain.

Treasurer's Report:

- Received membership money from GBN totaling \$2,025.
- Currently \$34,000. in the bank, over \$8,000. of that is FPP .

Concession's Report:

- Looking for a good price point on Hershey bars.

Show Meals:

- Need to figure out for Group Interp. Panera Bread is off the table due to allergy issues.
- Goode & Fresh for Cinderella.

Volunteering:

- Need volunteers for Variety Show.
- Concessions will sell after the shows on Friday and Saturday, not Thursday.
- Dr. Tarjan will serve pizza dinner on February 10th for Variety Show. Need 16 volunteers for serving from 6:00-8:00. The kids will eat between the two runs.

Fundraising:

- Shoe fundraiser starting March 6 will run for 6 weeks. Volunteers needed to drop off collection cardboard boxes.
- Thinking about kick-off event for fundraiser. Might want to have the event during lunch periods and at half-time during the TLS basketball game. Provide Dunkin' Donuts gift cards etc. to inspire and motivate.
- Open mic night is a big fundraiser.
- Raised \$202.00 during the CTPO fundraiser at California Pizza Kitchen.
- Advertise upcoming events in front of concessions table.

New Business:

- Senior scholarships:
 - History of scholarships: 2 years ago students wrote an essay to attach to application and submit
 - 3 years ago there was a short answer google form to submit on line. They were scored using a point system.
- Need to come up with assessment tool. Questions that engage self-reflection about the student's service and participation. How complicated or simple do we make this?
- Form needs to be given to seniors before spring break (end of March).
- Roughly 5 scholarships will be awarded.
- When considering what to ask it's important to note what students actively participated in . Sometimes they audition for something and don't make it. Their attempts should be considered.
