Theater Report from Julie Ann Hill (not present at meeting)

- Auditions for Mamma Mia went well and we have a very talented cast comprised of 85 students. We were very happy with the process overall. With a record number of kids auditioning (over 150!) they weren't able to take everyone, so we hope those students who were not cast will choose to work on crew.

- Auditions for the freshman-sophomore play "Winnie-the-Pooh" will take place next Wednesday 3/13 and Thursday 3/14 after school in the Drama Room. This play is open to freshman and sophomores only, and there will be no cuts. Parts will be determined based on audition, but we are looking forward to giving any frosh-soph the opportunity to part of a show if they choose to audition. The show goes up April 25-27, with an in-school matinee for first and second graders on Friday, April 26. We already have 600+ kids coming, so that's going to be a lot of fun! Alison Wilensky and Evan Denenberg are directing this project, with assistance from Emma Gradman. I will be guiding them through the process.
- Contest Play/GI rehearsals are underway and we are madly preparing for our public performances on Thursday 3/14 and Friday 3/15 at 7:00 in the CPA. Because there are only 20 students involved in this show, we need to get the word out that the public performances are open to all. Tickets are \$8 and will be sold at the door. Activity passes will be accepted. The Sectional Tournament is at Fremd High School on Saturday 3/16. Our performance times have not yet been determined.
- The Advanced Acting/Directing/Improv class will be performing their acting showcase during the day on Friday, April 5. If your kid is in this class, you may come to the show, but please email me ahead of time so I can let attendance know. The current plan is to present it during block 4-5 (9:30 a.m.) for classes.
- Our crew requirement has been reduced to 15 hours in order to encourage more students to complete it. Anyone wanting to be on the Theatre Board must do their 15 hours prior to submitting their application.
