Chad Davidson

- Fall Choir Concert was a huge success.
- Esther Kelly "went above and beyond," coming in daily for almost 2 weeks, to work on costumes.
- Auditions for V-Show vocal ensemble next week. 21 kids auditioning.
- Next event, Choir Fest on Monday, November 8th for junior high students from feeder schools and current GBN students. All extra-curricular ensembles will perform.
 Student-focused event to introduce students to choir and ideally encourage them to join.
- Choir has a full concert season planned.
- Choir, band and orchestra concert will happen in December. Directors are investigating live-streaming the concert during the day so students can watch. People can share on their social.
- Continuing to follow COVID safety protocols.
