Selection Process – Eligibility

1. Nominations

All nominations for selection to the New Jersey State Trapshooting Hall of Fame shall be submitted to the Hall of Fame Committee on an Official Nomination Form.

Official Nomination Forms shall be available:

1. At all member clubs.
2. From the New Jersey State Trapshooting Association website.
3. During the New Jersey State Shoot.

2. Recommendations

All nominees under either the competitor, contributor, or combined categories:

1. Should have resided in the State of New Jersey for at least **20** years.
2. Should have been a competitor or contributor for at least **20** years.
3. Must be or have been a member of the Amateur Trapshooting Association.

Hall Of Fame nominees shall be selected from three (3) categories:

1. **Participant-** a shooter who has made impressive records in registered trapshooting competitions at the State, Zone or National Level.
2. **Contributor-** a person who has voluntarily contributed to the promotion, administration, management, improvement and growth of registered trapshooting in New Jersey.
3. **Combined-** a combination of both of the aforementioned categories.

A maximum of two (2) persons may be inducted into the New Jersey Trapshooting Hall of Fame each year. It shall not be mandatory to select an inductee or inductees annually unless a deserving candidate or candidates actually exist.
