### Springtime at DSC

Springtime is just around the corner and wildlife will be more active in the coming months. For your physical and legal protection:

**Please DO NOT feed the alligators!** Not only is it illegal to feed alligators in SC, feeding alligators can result in animals losing fear of humans and becoming dangerous. Please do not dispose of fish bait or fish scraps in the water as this can also lead to dangerous encounters with wildlife.

Also, all species of the Canada goose are protected under the Migratory Bird Treaty Act—it is a federal offense to capture, harm or kill these birds or any part of their nests or eggs. Violations are punishable by both fine and imprisonment so **please DO NOT disturb the birds or their nests!**
