CPLA Lake Host Program History

- Started in 2019
- Supported by member contributions and NH LAKES grant
- Provided 154 hours of inspectors at Newton Boat Ramp
- One paid inspector worked 53 hours
- Volunteers provided 101 hours
- Inspected several boats coming from infested water bodies
- Educated many boaters about Clean, Drain and Dry requirements – *NH law*





Country Pond Infestations



- Good News! Country Pond is not known to be infested by milfoil
- However Chinese Mystery Snails have been reported and Spiny Naiad was observed in Fall 2019
- Weed Watchers will be on the lookout for all invasive species and report to NHDES
- Nearby waterbodies have milfoil and zebra clams
- Don't let this happen to Country Pond!



Lake Host Program 2020

- Working to *expand* ramp coverage
- Funding from member contributions, NH LAKES grant and this year's *Newton warrant article*
- Two paid inspectors and assistant coordinator – *increasing from 53 to 357 paid inspection hours!*
- However, that's just 25 hours per week, about 5 hours for 5 days per week.
- Volunteers are urgently needed for more complete coverage





Covid-19 Modifications for 2020

- Lake Host Inspections are considered an essential service
- Physical distance will be maintained
- Masks will be required and are provided
- Hand sanitizer will be provided
- No literature will be handed out
- Inspectors must certify they are symptom free before each shift
