Weed Watcher Program

- Adopt a section of shoreline
- Check periodically for invasive plants and animals
- Training kits are available
- Contact coordinator with findings
 - Need new coordinator
 - Coordinator reports findings NHDES
- Good News! No milfoil so far
- Spiny Naiad spotted last fall monitor growth
- Chinese mystery snails
 – please remove if found
- More Watchers are needed!





Weed Watcher Committee Chair



- Main contact point for Weed Watchers
- Coordinator organizes and tracks the weed watchers' activities
- Regular surveys of Country Pond shoreline, ideally every 2 – 4 weeks in summer
- Reports invasive or suspicious findings to NHDES
- Coordinator reports activities and findings to Board at monthly meetings
- CPLA needs a Weed Watcher Coordinator!



Spiny Naiad – Next Steps

- Following stakeholder survey, CPLA requested hand harvest / diver assisted suction (DASH)
- NHDES will survey again in July
- As needed, harvesting in August before plants produce seed
- First season contracting, permitting and treatment costs paid 100% by NHDES
- NHDES pays only 25 40% in subsequent years
