• DES Provides, training, loaner equipment, and lab testing




Why Do We Test?


 Lake is considered compromised "Mesotrophic"


 Establish a baseline, and keep historical quality records

 Data collection is critical to help improve water quality

2023 VLAP Testing Data Review



- Chlorophyll; slight increase but stable
- Conductivity; remains > than state median
- Color; changed from tea to dark brown
- Phosphorus; increase and > state median
- Transparency; increase and > state median
- Turbidity; slightly elevated, rain, Cyanobacteria
- PH; slightly acidic, but in desired range



Reduced quality due to high rain, but with less rain, quality improves by year end
