ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY INFORMATION

The Spring Hope Pumpkin Pageant is a natural, wholesome pageant open to girls and young women of all backgrounds residing in or near Nash County and surrounding areas of North Carolina. Our pageant celebrates community spirit, inner beauty, poise, and the joy of the Spring Hope National Pumpkin Festival.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Contestants must compete in their correct age division based on age as of the day of the competition.
- Reigning title holders from other pageant systems are welcome to enter unless their system prohibits participation in outside events.
- All contestants and their parents/guardians must agree to abide by all rules set forth in this packet.

Entry fees are non-refundable unless the event is cancelled by the director. No refunds will be issued for no-shows, withdrawals after the deadline, or disqualification.

HOW TO ENTER

- Complete the official Application / Entry Form (see last page of this packet).
- Obtain required signatures (contestant and parent/guardian if under 18).
- Submit completed form with entry fee payment to the pageant director.
- **Payment accepted by CHECK Payable to NASH ARTS COUNCIL - NO PAYMENTS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED BEFORE JULY 5TH, 2026**
- Confirmation will be sent to the email address on file once registration is processed.
- All contestants will receive a contestant packet by email at least one week prior to the event.

Age Divisions & Rehearsal Schedule

AGE DIVISIONS

Contestants compete in the age division corresponding to their age on the day of the competition. The director reserves the right to combine divisions with fewer than three contestants.

JUDGING CRITERIA

All competitions are judged on a 100-point scale by a panel of qualified, impartial judges with backgrounds in pageantry, education, performing arts, or community service. Judges are not affiliated with any contestant or family.

General Rules & Participation Guidelines

The Spring Hope Pumpkin Pageant is committed to creating a positive, respectful, and fun experience for all contestants, families, and guests. All participants are expected to read and abide by the following rules. Signing the entry form constitutes agreement to all rules and policies.

CONDUCT & SPORTSMANSHIP

- Good sportsmanship is required at all times — before, during, and after the event. Unsportsmanlike behavior by contestants, parents, or guests is grounds for immediate disqualification or removal from the venue.
- Negative comments about other contestants, their families, or their appearance will not be tolerated.
- Any harassment, bullying, or intimidation — in person or on social media — may result in disqualification and forfeiture of any title or award.
- Parents and family members are representatives of their contestant. Please set a positive example for all participating children.
- Directors, judges, and staff decisions are final. Scores, rankings, and judging are not subject to challenge or appeal.

ATTIRE GUIDELINES

- All clothing must be age-appropriate. The director reserves the right to request a change of attire if an outfit is deemed inappropriate.
- Evening gowns should be elegant and tasteful. Floor-length preferred for divisions 12 and older; shorter formal gowns acceptable for younger divisions.
- Casual Wear should reflect each contestant's individual style — off-the-rack or custom. Minimal rhinestones and sequins are acceptable.
- No revealing, suggestive, or otherwise inappropriate attire at any time.
- Hair extensions are permitted. Hair should look natural, soft, and polished.
- Makeup should be age-appropriate. Contestants under age 10 are encouraged to wear minimal, natural makeup only.

PHOTOGRAPHY & MEDIA

- By entering the pageant, contestants and their families consent to the use of photographs and video taken during the event for promotional purposes by the Spring Hope Pumpkin Pageant and the Spring Hope National Pumpkin Festival.
- Personal photography is welcome in audience areas. Flash photography from the audience is discouraged during competition to avoid distracting contestants.
- Please be respectful when photographing other contestants — always obtain permission before posting photos of other participants on social media.

VENUE & SAFETY RULES

- Contestants must remain in designated backstage areas unless otherwise directed by staff.
- No food or beverages allowed in the backstage area (water permitted).
- Parents/guardians of contestants ages 12 and under are permitted backstage. Contestant helpers (one per contestant) are allowed for all ages.
- The pageant organizers, venue, and the Spring Hope National Pumpkin Festival are not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.
- In the event of a medical emergency, please notify staff immediately.

COMPETITION RULES

- Age divisions are determined by age on the day of the competition — no exceptions.
- Contestants must be present and ready when their division is called. Contestants who miss their segment may not be permitted to compete in that segment.
- Props are not permitted during Evening Gown or Casual Wear unless approved in advance by the director.
- On-Stage Questions will be provided by the emcee from a prepared pool of age-appropriate questions. Contestants may not preview questions in advance.
- Each contestant is responsible for knowing the competition order.
- Titles and awards may be revoked if the winner is found to have misrepresented their age, identity, or eligibility.

DISCLAIMERS & LIABILITY

- The Spring Hope Pumpkin Pageant, its directors, staff, and volunteers are not liable for any injury, accident, or illness occurring on the premises.
- All entry fees are non-refundable. No credits or transfers will be issued unless the event is cancelled by the director.
- The director reserves the right to modify the schedule, combine age divisions, add categories, or make any operational adjustments necessary to ensure a quality event.
- This pageant is a natural pageant
- The pageant is not affiliated with any national pageant system unless explicitly stated. Titles are local and non-transferable to other systems.
- Results are final. All judging is conducted independently and confidentially.



Queen Duties & Expectations

Congratulations, Queen! With your crown comes the privilege of representing our community.

Holding a Spring Hope Pumpkin Pageant title is an honor and a responsibility. Queens are ambassadors of the Spring Hope National Pumpkin Festival, Nash County, and the spirit of community that makes our town special. The following guidelines outline what is expected of titleholders during their reign.

REQUIRED APPEARANCES

All division queens are required to make a minimum of four (4) official appearances during their reign year. Miss Pumpkin Queen may be asked for additional appearances at the director's request.

| Spring Hope Pumpkin Festival — Main Stage | Day of Festival | Appear on the main stage during the festival for congratulatory recognition. Queens will be introduced and celebrated before the crowd. |
| Additional Community Appearances | As arranged | Ribbon cuttings, school events, nonprofit fundraisers, etc. Coordinate with the director. |

QUEEN MAGNETS

As part of your reign, you will have the opportunity to order personalized queen magnets featuring your official name, title, and year.

- Magnet orders are placed independently through the director's approved vendor. Information provided after crowning.
- Magnets should be ordered within 30 days of crowning to ensure delivery before your first appearance.
- Magnet costs are the responsibility of the titleholder and are separate from all pageant fees.

REIGN CONDUCT & SOCIAL MEDIA

- Queens are expected to conduct themselves with grace, kindness, and professionalism both in person and online during their entire reign.
- Social media posts in an official capacity (wearing crown/sash) should reflect positively on the pageant and the Spring Hope community.
- Do not post negative, controversial, or inappropriate content while serving as a titleholder.
- Queens are encouraged to use their platform to promote community involvement, local events, and the Spring Hope Pumpkin Festival.
- Tagging the pageant's official social media accounts in appearance photos is encouraged and appreciated.

CROWN & SASH CARE

- Queens are responsible for the care and safekeeping of their crown and sash throughout their reign.
- Crowns should be stored safely when not in use. Crown cases will be provided where available.
- Queens are expected to return crowns at the following year's pageant for the crowning ceremony. Failure to return the crown may result in a replacement fee.
- Sashes are yours to keep and display with pride!
