2025 Rules and Regulations

- 1. Each game consists of two 20-minute halves.
- 2. The clock runs continuously except for the last 2 minutes of the 2nd half.
- 3. Overtime: If the game is tied at the end of regulation, a 3-minute overtime period will be played. The clock will stop with less than 1 minute remaining. Each team will receive one additional timeout. If the game is still tied after the first overtime, additional overtime periods will continue until a winner is determined. No extra timeouts will be given after the first overtime.
- 4. A 4-point shot can be made if BOTH feet are within the logo boundary.
- 5. Foul shots: A 1-and-1 free throw occurs on the 7th team foul, and two free throws are awarded on the 10th team foul.
- 6. Teams are allowed three timeouts, each lasting 60 seconds, per game.
- 7. Ball advancement is allowed once per half following a timeout.
- 8. Players must:
- a. Wear an approved uniform that matches the team's colors and includes a number. One technical foul will be assessed for each player infraction, resulting in 2 points being awarded to the opposing team. For example, four illegal uniforms result in 8 points being awarded to the opposing team.
- b. Arrive with at least four players who are appropriately dressed 15 minutes before the game. Failure to comply will result in a forfeit, and entry fees will not be refunded. Teams are still responsible for paying the officials' fees.
- 9. Fighting, aggressive behavior, and profanity will result in ejection from the game without a refund.
- 10. No player roster changes are allowed after the 3rd week of each session.
- 11. Players must participate in at least three games to qualify for the tournament.
- 12. Teams must pay a \$30 referee fee per official 15 minutes before the game.
