We would like to welcome people back to the church building in September, assuming the guidance does not change. The church has been consulted about a possible plan for the coming month and therefore the current proposal will be the following: -

Our church service this coming Sunday 13th will be **online only**.

- In addition, on **September 13th** there will be a **Teaching and Communion Service at 6.30pm** in the church building when Geoff Smith will continue the series on Revelation – chapters 2 & 3.

On **September 20th** we will have our **first 11.15am Morning Service** since the lockdown when Stephen Taylor will lead a Harvest Service.

On **September 27th at 11.15am** Geoff Smith will speak on Mark 7:1-23 – ‘Rebuked by Jesus.’

We are aware of the needs of those who are not able to make the services at present, and so therefore the services will be **online as well**. This will be for as long those unable to come will benefit.

Prayer Meetings will alternate between the church building (this week, September 10th) and Zoom (September 17th). At this stage it is difficult to gauge how a Prayer Meeting in the building will go, so given positive Zoom meetings it makes sense to do this in the immediate future.

Other Church Actives will not recommence yet but will be continually reviewed.

When we meet, we will need to follow government guidance to try and prevent the spread of the virus. One aspect of this is that the maximum number of people the church hall can accommodate is about 36 if we are to keep 2 meters apart. We may therefore need to know in advance if you plan to come to a service so we can ensure we can accommodate everyone.

Continue to pray that the elders and the fellowship may be guided on the timing of going back to some normality, and in doing so, not put anyone at risk. Let us continue to pray for one another in the different needs we have at this time.
