The PASS System is here:- We are extremely pleased to advise that our care service is starting to use an electronic care planning and care notes system which commenced in October 2019 called PASS, Already live in the Leasowe, Moreton, Hoylake and Upton areas, our care workers will soon be using this mobile based system across all areas of Wirral to receive care plans and assessment documents, electronically. They will then enter their care notes and medication records, on their mobile phone as opposed to using paper records that we previously used.

The new system has substantial advantages:

- As soon as we hear that there is a change in medication from the pharmacy, surgery, carers, district nurses or even the service user, we are able to update our systems and advise our care workers immediately without having to deliver new paperwork to the address.
- When there is a change in the care plan we are able to make this change immediately at the touch of a button.
- Running alongside our electronic call monitoring system to ensure attendance, we will also monitor and be alerted if specific tasks such as medication or other care tasks have not been completed. We will then be able to get in touch to put this right as soon as a call has been completed. This helps to safeguard your loved ones offering the trust and reassurance you want and need.

Gary Nagle, Director of Operations states 'The introduction of PASS ....

... marks a substantial improvement to the way we deliver our home care service. Should any health or social care professional or family member contact our office or on-call service out of hours, we will have full access and knowledge of all care and medication delivered, real time. By using OpenPass 24/7 this also gives family members the opportunity to view care delivery at any location, 24 hours a day, offering assurances that their loved ones are receiving safe, responsive and effective care. Here at Professional Carers we continually seeking new and innovative ways to improve our services and to date the feedback about PASS has been fantastic. We are working hard in the background to deploy this across all areas of Wirral and our next area to go Live is Birkenhead. It is our intention to roll out this system throughout Wallasey as we enter the new year'.
