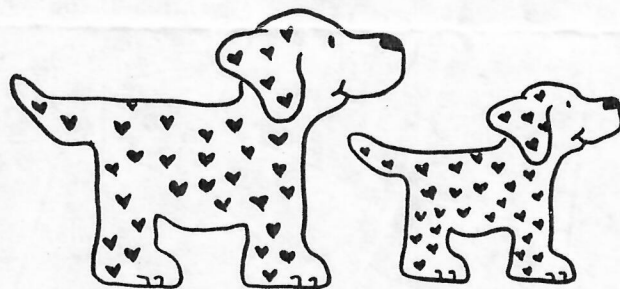
The President's Spot

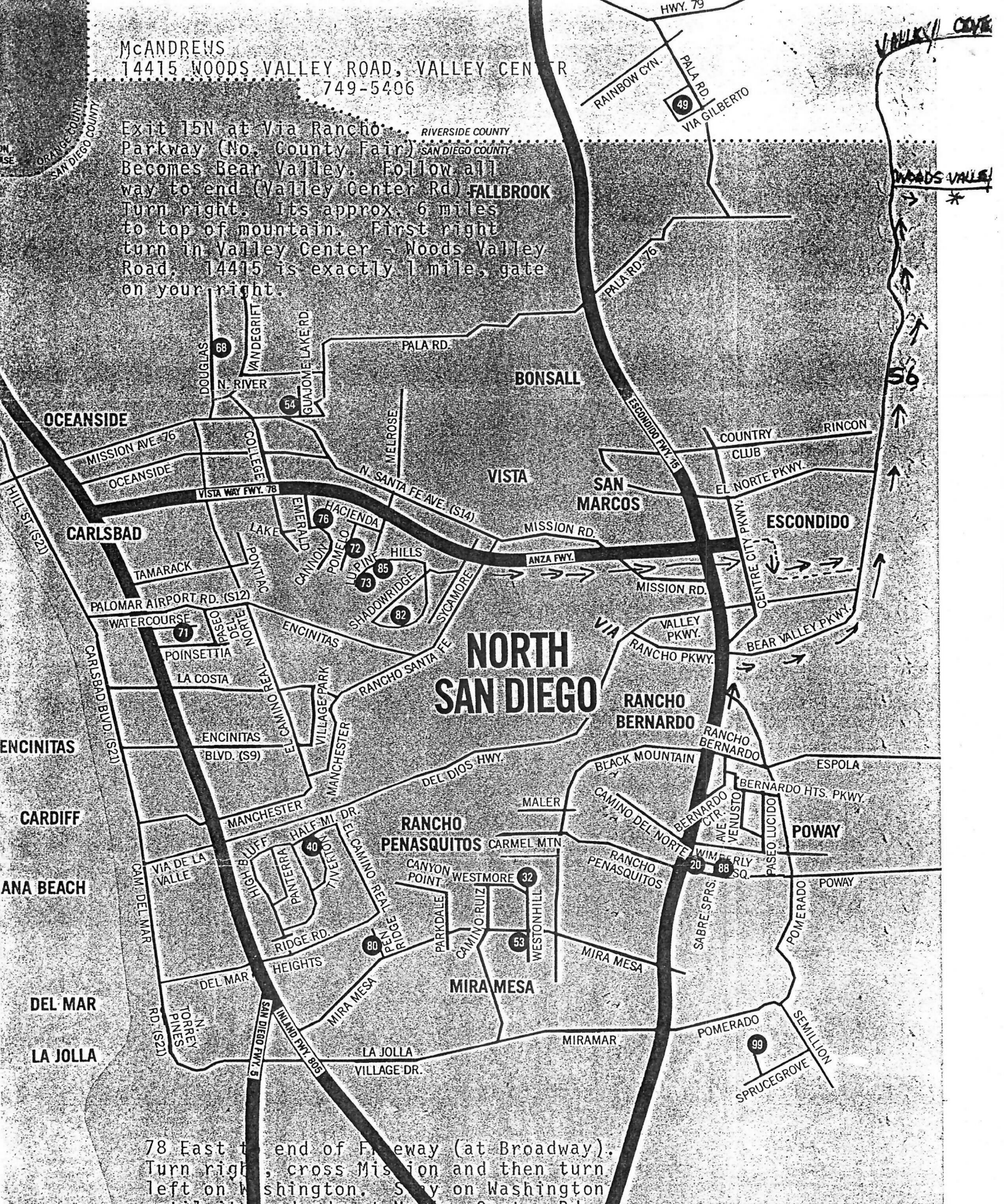

STANDING RULES AND REGULATIONS

These are the rules and regulations which are proposed to govern the Dalmatian Club of San Diego County. The above committee members met July 3, 1991:

- 1) The regular monthly meeting will be held the second Wednesday of each month at 7:30PM at a mid county location, place to be determined by the Board of Directors.
- 2) Board of Directors shall meet at the discretion of the Board, however, there shall be at least four meetings per year.
- 3) Dues shall be \$15.00 per year per member. There will be a \$5.00 one time initiation fee. Charter members shall be exempt from the initiation fee.
- 4) A yearly audit of the treasurers books shall be done by two members, excluding the Treasurer. Only one of the auditing committee may be serving on the board. The audit will be done during the month of November. It will be presented at the December meeting.
- 5) The Club shall have a monthly publication which shall be called "Dot to Dot". Dot to Dot is to be mailed to editors of Dalmatian columns in magazines and editors of all reciprocating Dalmatian club publications. This publication will be sent free to all members and honorary members. It shall be mailed first class.
- 6) Committees shall be formed in the following areas:
 - a) Wellness Committee
 - b) Awards Committee
 - c) Education Committee
 - d) Trophy Committee
 - e) Annual Dinner Committee
 - f) Program Committee
 - g) Membership Committee
 - h) Hospitality Committee

- i) Public Relations Committee
- j) Budget Committee
- k) Speciality Committee

These committees will comprise of one or more members and shall be formed at the time of need. The FIRST formation of each committee will be responsible for writing procedures for such committee, to be approved by the Board of Directors. One member may be eligible to serve on more than one committee simultaneously.
