**DIRECTIONS TO THE BOISE GUN CLUB**

**From the East**

Exit 64 from I-84 at Black's Creek-Kuna Exit and travel west on Kuna-Mora Road for 6 miles or exit on the Gowen Road Exit and travel Gowen Road west for 3 miles, then go south on Pleasant Valley Road for 6 miles to Kuna-Mora Road then east 1 mile.

**From the West:**

From I-84 take Orchard (#52) exit. Go south on Orchard. Orchard Street merges with Gowen Road and turns south-east. Follow traffic along Gowen Road approximately ¼ mile to Pleasant Valley Road. Turn south on Pleasant Valley Road for approximately 6 miles to Kuna-Mora Road. (You will pass the Idaho State Prison). At the intersection of Pleasant Valley and Kuna-Mora Road, turn east on Kuna-Mora Road. The club is on the north side of the road approximately ¾ of a mile east of the intersection.

## **SHOOT RULES AND INFORMATION**

### ***VOICE RELEASE SYSTEMS WILL BE USED ON ALL TRAPS!***

#### **REGISTRATION**

Registration and Squadding will be available 1-6 pm Thursday May 21, 2026 and beginning 7:30 A.M. each morning of the shoot.

1. Take your ATA card to the handicap table. Have your average card ready, with all averages up to date, including a doubles average. (Note: SOS Shooting Software has history to determine ATA & PITA shooting history and class eligibility. It is also the shooter's responsibility to have evidence of shooting history available). **If you are going to cross-register targets, it is your responsibility to notify the handicap table and the cashier to cross register your targets.**
2. Specialty Classes: It is your responsibility to confirm special category with the handicap. Special Categories are:  
LD1, LD2, SUB VT, VET, SR VET, SUB JR, JR, JR GOLD
3. Select events, purses and options prior to arriving at the cashiering windows.
4. Go to Squadding Window for squad assignments.
5. Take all forms to the cashiering window. Make all checks payable to the Idaho State Trapshooting Association (ISTA).

Any shooter who wishes to squad another shooter must have the second shooter's permission, and the necessary forms (average card, plastic card, ATA number etc.) to facilitate the handicapping process.

## **SHOOT RULES AND INFORMATION**

### **ADVANCE SQUADDING**

This is encouraged, and can be done on SOS Clays You must still go through the Handicap Table upon arrival at the club.

### **SCORERS & SCORING**

Your score will be called at the end of each 5 shots, 10 for Doubles. It is the duty of the contestant to have any error corrected before he/she has fired the first shot at the succeeding position or in the case of his last post before he/she leaves the trap. No corrections for mismarked targets can be made after the squad has departed the trap.

### **TARGET SETTING**

Target setting will be under the direction of the ISTA and the Host Club. No targets will be changed without permission from an ISTA or Host Club Director.

### **REFUNDS**

No entry fees, purses or options will be refunded after the event has started. All refunds will be mailed to the shooters with the payoffs.

### **LATE SHOOTERS**

Watch your squad number. No Shooter will be called on the speaker. Shooters missing their squad will be re-squadded only if they pay a \$10.00 re-squadding fee. There will be NO waiting period.

### **ATA POINTS**

Maximum ATA points for resident and non-resident shooters will be available at this shoot. Please read the current rules regarding awarding of points.

### **MONEY DIVISION**

All purses and added money divided High Gun System unless otherwise noted. No Monies can be played after the first squad takes the line in any given event.

### **IDAHO CLUB TEAM RACE**

Must consist of one AA, one A, one B, one C, and one D shooter. A lower class shooter can move up classes. Team must enter before first half of singles race starts. One Team per Idaho Club.

### **SHOOT OFFS**

Day one preliminary event ties will be carried over to the next like event, unless a shoot off is needed because of a change in yardage (i.e. a tie results in earned yardage). There will be a shoot off held for all other events including Championship Events. A shoot-off committee of the ISTA Directors and State Delegate will conduct and oversee all shoot offs. Please see them for any information concerning shoot offs.

NOTE: REASONABLE EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO NOTIFY YOU OF A SHOOT OFF, HOWEVER YOU MUST BE PRESENT WHEN CALLED OR FORFEIT.

### **HOA AND HAA SCORES**

High Over All and High All Around scores will be computed by the cashier and posted following Event #10. Shooters will be responsible for checking these sheets for errors and notify the score board personnel/cashier. The 16 yard classification of a shooter in Event #1 will be used to determine HOA classification.

**NOTE: ISTA does NOT advance classes based on preliminary event winners.**

# Classification

## PENALTY YARDAGE AND CLASSIFICATION

The handicap committee may assign a MINIMUM of 22 yards and Class B Singles and Class B Doubles to any shooter who does not have an established shooting history; however, any trapshooting history may be used to establish classification and yardage. In all cases, known ability will have a strong bearing on classification. A shooter belonging to another shooting association will be required to shoot from his or her longest yardage. Any questions may be referred to the Handicap Committee for evaluation.

### TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded at the conclusion of shooting each day; it is the shooters responsibility to make arrangements for someone to pick-up or arrange to have the trophies mailed if the shooter has to leave before the trophies are finalized. If trophies are mailed, shooter will be responsible for postage.

### 100 and 200 STRAIGHTS

The ISTA has 100 and 200 straight pins available.  
If you qualify, please see Kathy Connerley or Spud Storey.

#### ALL-AMERICAN POINTS WILL BE AVAILABLE IN ALL OF THE EVENTS AT THIS SHOOT

There is only one "type" of All American points now. There are no longer separate "trophy" points and "tie" points.

Trophies are no longer required to be given in order for points to be awarded.

ALL shooters breaking the TOP THREE SCORES in Resident and Non-Resident special category will ALWAYS receive All American points. Please review Appendix II of the Official ATA rules for complete information regarding All American Points.

## NOTICE OF TAXATION



The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) requires that anyone making \$2000 or more at a shoot report those earnings to the IRS via the shoot host. In order for the shoot host to do this required reporting, we MUST have the Social Security Number (SSN) or Tax ID of the shooters that win \$2000 or more. This is accomplished by completing an IRS Form W9. If you think you may have \$2000 or more in winnings, please legibly complete a W9 form and return it to Kathy Connerley or the Cashier's desk. Checks will not be mailed to winners of \$2000 or more until a W9 is on file.

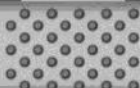

## IDAHO TRAPSHOOTING HALL OF FAME

The Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame, formed in 1988, is a nonprofit organization with the following mission "To record and memorialize significant people, places and events in the history of trapshooting in the state of Idaho and to promote trapshooting and educate the public as to the values of the sport of and to preserve the history, records, artifacts and other memorabilia as well as to promote and provide inspiration to all trap shooters". Over the past 33 years 45 people have been inducted into the Idaho Hall of Fame, becoming part of the Idaho trapshooting legacy. The Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame offers college scholarships to high school senior who have actively participated in the sport of trapshooting. Application materials are available through any board member. Nominations for the Hall of Fame can be made for future induction consideration. Nominations are due by May 1st for the following year.

The Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame raises funds to achieve the mission through fundraising, donations, and Lewis Purses at Idaho trap shoots where a portion of the option fee is returned to the Hall of Fame. Funds are used for recognition events and scholarships.

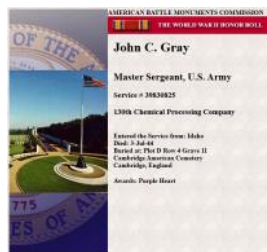

## GRANT WILLIAMS: 2026 Inductee Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame

We would like to recognize Grant Williams for achievement, sportsmanship, and commitment to trapshooting. A native of Kellogg, Idaho, Grant currently resides in Kingston with his wife Cari and their two children, an eight-year-old son and six-year-old daughter. He is the son of Darin and Beth Williams and brother to Garrett Williams. Professionally, Grant works as a Journeyman Main fitter for Avista Utilities, balancing a demanding career with his passion for trapshooting.

Grant's journey in competitive shooting began at the remarkable age of 11, though he recalls his earliest experiences breaking targets at just eight years old, around the year 2000. By 2003, he was already registering targets, setting the stage for an outstanding career. From the outset, Grant distinguished himself on the trap fields, dominating Sub Junior and Junior divisions, amassing most of the available trophies across Idaho. His success has carried into adulthood, where he continues to add state and national titles to his impressive résumé.

Described by friends and family as soft-spoken, humble, friendly, and hard-working, Grant embodies the very best qualities of a champion athlete and role model. These traits, though unexpected in the world of high-level competition, have only amplified his respect and admiration among peers.

Grant Williams' competitive record is nothing short of extraordinary. His Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA) career fills eight pages, each brimming with championship-caliber performances. Notably, he and his father Darin are the first father-son duo to both be inducted into the Idaho State Trapshooting Hall of Fame—a testament to their family's deep roots in the sport. Grant's trophy count as a champion is stunning: Utah: 3; Idaho: 58; Oregon: 5; Inland Empire: 5; Washington: 29; Western Zone: 15; Montana: 7; Grand American: 6

Grant's victories at the Grand American, the premier event in the sport, began in 2007 at age 16 with several trophies, including President Handicap Sub Junior runner-up, Clay Target Sub Junior runner-up, All-Around semi-finalist, and Doubles runner-up champion. In 2010, he captured Junior trophies for Clay Target Champion, Clay Target McGarry, Kolar Arms Handicap runner-up, and Gun Stock Doubles runner-up.

A highlight of Grant's career came in August 2022, when he captured the 123rd Grand American Trapshooting High All-Around Championship in Sparta, Illinois. Competing against more than 3,000 of the world's top shooters, Grant's aggregate score of 398 out of a possible 400 cemented his status as one of the finest 12-gauge trapshooters globally. His victory was celebrated by shooters across Idaho, all proud to watch him bring home the prestigious High All-Around Award.

Trapshooting excellence runs deep in the Williams family. Grant's father, Darin, and uncle, Beaver are both accomplished shooters, following in the footsteps of their father, Floyd Williams. The tradition continues into the next generation, with Beaver's son Derek and Darin's sons, Grant and Garrett, carrying the torch. Darin's own place in the Hall of Fame foreshadowed Grant's inevitable induction.

Grant's winning ways have not slowed. In 2023 alone, he claimed titles such as 100 Handicap Champion (8th), Double AA, All-Around Champion runner-up, NRA Singles AAA, Doubles Champion and AAA runner-up, and Doubles Champion AAA 5<sup>th</sup> place.

His overall ATA target milestones as of January 24, 2025, are remarkable: Singles: 45,800 targets; Doubles: 32,500 targets; Handicap: 46,300 targets

He achieved 25,000 targets in Handicap (8/11/2014), Singles (5/28/2015), and Doubles (6/14/2021), and has been an ATA Life Membership since July 10, 2009. His All-American Team placements include Junior 3rd in 2011 and Open 1st in 2023. He completed the prestigious Grand Slam on July 27, 2013.

Congratulations to Grant Williams on his induction into the 2026 Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame. His legacy is defined by his competitive excellence, unwavering humility, and enduring family tradition. As he joins his father in the Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame, we honor him for his achievements and his profound impact on trapshooting.

JOHNNY C. GRAY 1905-1944 2026 Posthumous Inductee Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame

While going through miscellaneous Hall of Fame files and paperwork at the Boise Gun Club, Kent Harris found information about Johnny Gray and recognized that this Idaho shooter deserved HOF recognition.

Johnny Clarence Gray was born June 18, 1905, in Boise Idaho. He grew up in Boise, and later moved to Nampa, graduating from Nampa High School in 1925. Johnny worked for his father's laundry business (Troy Laundry). He registered for the military draft in 1940 or 1941 at 35 years of age and entered the US Army in 1942 or 43. Because of his experience in the laundry business, he was eventually assigned to the 130th Chemical Processing Company with rank of Master Sgt. John was in charge of running a laundry in England when he was killed on July 3, 1944. He is buried in an English WWII cemetery, and a photo of his headstone is included in this application.

Johnny grew up in a shooting family and was a third-generation shooter. (Boise Gun Club records). Growing up, Johnny spent a lot of time at the Boise Gun Club with his grandfather, John G. Gray, who was shooting in the very early 1900's and was still shooting on the late 1920's.

*(Editor's note: As you read about this fine man, please remember to note the conditions trap shooters in those years had to take into consideration. Plastic ammunition and in particular plastic wads did not appear until the early 1960's. You either shot paper hulls, or even brass hulls were available, although most of these were used for black powder guns. Reloading was much more involved and even required certain specific pressures to be used to seat the felt wads of the time, hence the competitions were 50 target events, and even 25 targets at some smaller league shoots. — MK)*

Johnny started his own shooting career in the 1920's, and even after moving to Nampa, he still considered Boise his home or main club. He usually shot on Boise teams at the many team shoots that were popular at that time (Elks team shoots, etc.). He also attended shoots throughout the West, including Oregon and Utah. Jon even shot at the Grand American Handicap at least once, in 1943 (a rare thing for a western shooter in those days), and was a winner. There was a special Army-Navy team race, with Army the winner, which included John Gray as a team member.

Johnny made significant contributions to Idaho trapshooting. At the local level, from the time he was a young boy in the 1910's to when he entered the military in the early 1940's he was involved with and support clubs such as Boise and Nampa. He helped run shoots and worked many projects (Boise Gun Club records). At the state level after the PITA was organized in the early 1930's, Johnny became active at the state level and helped run Idaho State Shoots, both ATA and PITA, until he went into the military in the early 1940's. Nationally, in 1934 or 1935 Johnny was a national PITA Director and in 1938 he served a term as President of the PITA, joining J. O. Cotant as the only other Idaho shooters to every hold that office.

It was mentioned in one of the shooting magazines of the day that Johnny was respected for his shooting ability and was well liked by his peers. His election as PITA President was cited as an example of this respect.

Johnny had many notable accomplishments during his shooting career. He held Idaho State Championships 12 times and won PITA Singles in 1935, 1936, 1940, and tied in Singles in 1941. He won HAA in 1936, and Doubles in 1941 and 1942. At the ATA he won HAA in 1933 and 1940. He won trophies in Doubles in 1933; Singles and Doubles in 1937 and Doubles in 1940. In 1938 he had the highest mid-year average for the entire PITA; in 1939 he had the second highest singles average for Idaho. In 1941 he was the PITA Eastern Zone shot singles champion, doubles R-U, HAA and long run for the year as well as the high singles average for Idaho. In 1942 he was high for Idaho in all three shooting disciplines. In 1943 he was on the Grand American winning team for the special Army-Navy team race. It is possible that these were the last registered targets he shot, as he was killed the following year.

For over 30 years Johnny Gray was around gun clubs, worked at gun clubs and shot at gun clubs. Many of his accomplishments have been lost to the passage of time, but it is safe to say that he was one of the greatest shooters to ever come out of the state of Idaho.

He was one of what has been called the "greatest generation" of Americans, and there is a saying about people who serve in the military that "All gave some and some gave all."

Johnny C Gray "gave all" on July 3rd, 1944, and a wonderful shooting career was cut short at its peak. May he rest in peace.

### **STARTING PURSE FOR THE 2026 IDAHO ATA STATE SHOOT**

### **\$2877.72**

Entry Fee for this non-compulsory option is \$3.00 each 50 for a total of \$18.00. Entry fees collected at this shoot will be added to the respective purses. Any two 25 straights win one-half of the respective purse. Each \$18.00 entry is eligible for one-half of any or all (i.e. 100 straight) of these purses. All ties divide respective monies.

#### **ATA DAILY FEES**

The ATA in its program of building strong state associations, aids them financially; from the \$20 annual membership, \$2 is returned to the state organization. From the \$500 life membership, \$150 is returned to the state organization over a ten (10) year period & part is retained in a special ATA emergency fund. From the \$4 daily fee, twenty percent (20%) is returned to the state organization.

These refunds are made to the State Association ten days prior to the State Tournament, provided such tournament is held and provided the State turns into the ATA at least \$200 from annual membership dues and registration fees. From this refund, there will be deducted an amount equal to any fines due because of late shoot reports. On or before January 1 of each year the ATA shall inform the secretary of each State of the approximate amount of refund to be paid to that state.

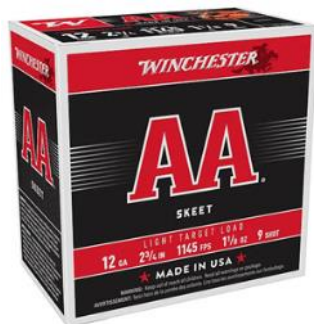

- A special display on Johnny Gray, one of this year's Idaho Hall of Fame inductees, featuring a score sheet from the 1933 State Shoot where he broke 100 straight, and the 1932 Flop Adams Trophy won by a three-shooter team that included Gray
- Sage hen and rabbit hunting photos from the early 1900s

And don't miss the reference library—over 60 binders and 130 books covering nearly every shotgun subject you can think of. A copy machine is available if you find something worth taking home.
