## Boise Gun Club League Rule Summary

- 1. Teams consist of five (5) shooters. Substitutions' may be allowed if a shooter cannot complete the remaining league schedule.
- 2. The regular league week begins on the Sunday prior to the scheduled Wednesday and extends to the following Sunday. That gives shooters three (3) opportunities to keep their scores current.
- 3. Shooters may also shoot in advance up to a maximum of 2 weeks, and can shoot from behind up to a maximum of 2 weeks. If you require more makeup days, notify the League Officer ahead of the next scheduled week.
- 4. The Team Captain is responsible for collecting and paying the team sponsor fee (\$125 ~ \$25 x 5) the fee shall be paid no later than the 3rd week of the league. Each captain will receive a complete copy of the trap league rules and should assure team members are aware of the rules. The Captain will also receive five copies of this summary, one for each teammate.
- 5. Reserve Scores: Declare and shoot a reserve. Your reserve score will be used if you are unable to shoot during the scheduled week. You may shoot a subsequent reserve once your reserve score has been used. After week four your reserve score will automatically be transferred to the first schedule league week for which you do not have a score.
- 6. If you do not have a reserve score and cannot shoot during the week. You may shoot from arrear twice (2). If you have used your makeup's, and did not notify the League Officer of your absence and the reason why, your score for the week will be counted as zero (0).
