

THE ORGANIZATION

The North American Consumer Protection Investigators (NACPI) is an association that provides a medium through which the consumer protection investigators, civil and criminal, of all levels of government receive educational training at annual conferences, network, exchange information, and cooperate in matters involving consumer protection investigations, education, and litigations, of mutual concern to all, which allow the consumer protection investigators to better assist, educate and serve the public in their employment with their respective governments.

NACPI membership consists of individuals employed by an agency, office, department or bureau of a federal, state, county, city, province, territory or district government such as investigators, supervisors of investigators, paralegals, analysts, agents, police officers' or persons engaged in the enforcement of consumer protection laws and other consumer laws (including but not limited to elder abuse/neglect/financial exploitation, health fraud, real estate fraud, computer/internet fraud and telecommunications fraud).

Divided into geographical regions of the United States, the US Territories, and Canada, NACPI is governed by a board of Officers and regional Directors and Deputy Directors. NACPI members meet at the annual conference, held in August, September, or October. Some regions also organize their own regional conferences during the year. The annual and regional meetings feature training workshops on techniques for investigating, managing and litigating consumer fraud cases, as well as informative seminars on important consumer fraud topics. NACPI members share information at roundtable sessions concerning current investigations, consumer education programs and new legislation. Access to the NACPI website and list serve of NACPI members is available to all NACPI members.

Any individual who qualifies for membership, pays annual dues of \$40.00, and abides by the By-Laws and Membership Oath of the North American Consumer Protection Investigators shall be a member.
