TWIN PORTS MUSIC FESTIVAL EXPANDS IN SECOND YEAR AT EARTH RIDER

Acclaimed blues guitarist Ana Popovic and Twin Cities-based folk songwriters The Cactus Blossoms headline this year's festival.

The Cactus Blossoms perform Friday; Popovic and her high-powered band perform Saturday. Them Coulee Boys, The Big Wu, Frogleg, Feed the Dog, Katy Guillen & the Drive and Duluth's Feeding Leroy round out the lineup.

The festival's organizers intentionally set out to give all performers a healthy amount of time on stage, and all acts have been allotted time for a 90-minute set.

- Duluth-based folk songwriters Feeding Leroy rounds out the lineup with their Friday set.
