Applicants must currently hold a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale or a minimum 3.5 GPA on a 5.0 scale.

Scholarship recipient(s) must be accepted as a full-time student at an accredited college, university, or trade school/community college program for the upcoming 2023-2024 academic year. Documentation of acceptance is required before award is presented.

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION - Incomplete applications will not be considered.

- **1. Attach your most recent unofficial high school transcript.** An official transcript is requested if awarded a scholarship.
- 2. Write an essay. Here is the essay topic and formatting requirements.
  - a. Topic The year 2021 greatly challenged our social, economic, and political norms, and many of these challenges continue in 2022.

Identify a specific national (not personal) event that occurred during this time and explain how it impacted your personal world view.

How will your chosen field of study make a difference in this area?

- b. Format The essay must be:
  - i. Double-spaced
  - ii. One-inch (1") margins
  - iii. Times New Roman font
  - iv. 12-point size
  - v. 400 words minimum and 500 words maximum
- 3. Three (3) letters of recommendation from the requested sources and attach them with the completed application. Here are the sources:
  - **a.** Attach a letter of recommendation from your **high school** teacher OR counselor OR principal on the school letterhead.
  - **b.** Attach a letter of recommendation from a leader of a **community organization** and/or house of worship on the organization letterhead.
  - c. Attach a letter of recommendation from an unrelated person of your choosing.
