GUIDELINES

DEADLINE to submit this application is *Friday, December 30, 2022*, at **5:00 p.m.** Email your scholarship application and all the required documents to rbl.scholarship@gmail.com.

You will be notified, by email and/or phone, about your application status by **Friday, January 20, 2023**.

Applicants must currently hold a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale or a minimum 3.5 GPA on a 5.0 scale.

Scholarship recipient(s) must be accepted as a full-time student at an accredited college, university, or trade school/community college program for the upcoming 2023-2024 academic year. Documentation of acceptance is required before award is presented.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION – *Incomplete applications will not be considered.*

1. **Attach your most recent unofficial high school transcript.** An official transcript is requested if awarded a scholarship.
2. **Write an essay. Here is the essay topic and formatting requirements.**
 - a. **Topic - *The year 2021 greatly challenged our social, economic, and political norms, and many of these challenges continue in 2022.***
Identify a specific national (not personal) event that occurred during this time and explain how it impacted your personal world view.
How will your chosen field of study make a difference in this area?
 - b. **Format - The essay must be:**
 - i. Double-spaced
 - ii. One-inch (1”) margins
 - iii. Times New Roman font
 - iv. 12-point size
 - v. 400 words minimum and 500 words maximum
3. **Three (3) letters of recommendation from the requested sources and attach them with the completed application.** Here are the sources:
 - a. Attach a letter of recommendation from your **high school** teacher OR counselor OR principal on the school letterhead.
 - b. Attach a letter of recommendation from a leader of a **community organization and/or house of worship** on the organization letterhead.
 - c. Attach a letter of recommendation from an **unrelated person** of your choosing.

Remember to complete a 2023-2024 Federal Student Aid Application (FASFA) <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>. This gives you access to more funding opportunities.

Please complete and return per the instructions found in the Guidelines. If anything is not applicable, enter “N/A” in the space.
