SPRING IS IN THE AIR!

The Spirit of Butts' Farm, also known as TAM 5, was the first model aircraft to cross the Atlantic Ocean on August 11, 2003. It flew from Cape Spear, Canada, to Mannin Beach, Ireland, in 38.9 hours, setting double world records for duration and distance. The aircraft was built by a team led by Maynard Hill and controlled by autopilot for over 99% of the flight. The plane is on display at the National Model Aviation Museum, with a backup model at the National Air and Space Museum.
