Crockpot Tuscan Chicken

This Crockpot Tuscan Chicken is made up juicy chicken breasts slowly cooked in a rich and cheesy cream sauce. This recipe takes just 10 minutes to prep and makes the perfect Diner served over your favorite pasta

Ingredients

- o 4 boneless skinless chicken breasts
- o ½ teaspoon salt
- o ½ teaspoon Italian seasoning
- o ¼ teaspoon paprika
- o 1/8 teaspoon black pepper

Sauce

- o 1 cup heavy cream
- o 1 tablespoon corn starch
- o 2 teaspoons minced garlic
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- o 1/8 teaspoon black pepper
- 1/3 cup sundried tomatoes chopped
- o ¼ cup shredded Parmesan cheese
- 1 cup chopped fresh spinach

Instructions

- 1. Place chicken breasts in a 2.5-4-quart slow cooker.
- 2. Combine salt, Italian seasoning, paprika, and pepper in a small bowl. Sprinkle evenly over chicken.
- 3. Stir together the sauce: add the cream, garlic, corn starch, salt and pepper to a medium bowl and whisk.
- 4. Stir in the sun-dried tomatoes and Parmesan cheese and pour around and over chicken in slow cooker.
- 5. Put the lid on and cook on low for three (3) hours or until chicken reaches an internal temperature of 165 degrees F. Stir in fresh spinach.
- 6. Remove from the crockpot and serve with pasta or as desired.
- 7. Top with shredded Parmesan cheese.
