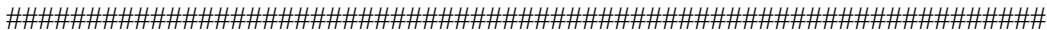

# FRIENDLY REMINDER OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

\*QUIET HOURS for campsites are between 11:00 pm and 8:00 am

\* Lot numbers are to be visible placed on Golf Carts, Pontoon, Paddle Boat, kayak

\*Campsites must be kept free of clutter, including equipment needing repair, boats, bikes plus any material on shore.

\*Storage of boat trailers, utility trailers, or similar items on a co-owners lot are prohibited between May 1<sup>st</sup> and October 31st.

\*Personal property (bikes, toys, wagons, tools, etc.) should be properly stored at the end of each day and put away when not here.

\*Grass must be cut regularly. Height of 6" or more will receive a violation of \$75.00 each required cut.

\*Anything that is rusted or deteriorating (bikes, wheelbarrows, firewood) should be removed from the premises.

\*Trees and shrubbery should be properly trimmed annually to avoid overgrowth and an unsightly appearance.

\*No co-owner will wire direct into any service box (limited common element) behind or in front of the circuit breakers. All connection to the electric service box must be approved (state code) 20 or 30 AMP plug in connections. Under no circumstances will any other electric plugs or boxes be attached to the electrical pedestal on each site.

\*Many of you will have friends visiting you, so make sure you have notified security of their arrival or have them on your visitor's card at the security booth. Guests are not allowed to bring in guests.

\*All Co-Owners are responsible for their guest understanding the rules and regulations.

\* All cars entering must have a co-owner windshield sticker or a rear mirror visitor pass visible to staff while on premises.
