Alternatives are:

- A fully integrated offshore grid shown to be cheaper & better in a National Grid video and in three independent reports since 2011
- **High Voltage Direct Current** from Norwich to Tilbury, either underground or subsea shown to be quicker, less risky and have lower lifetime costs
- **Upgrading the existing grid.** For example, using TS Conductors, now licensed for use in the UK and part-owned by National Grid, and other grid enhancing technologies.
