## WHAT IS KIDS ROCK CAMP?

Kids Rock Camp is an **annual, overnight camp** hosted by the PAONL. Our camp gives your kids the opportunity to get away from everyday life, build friendships & focus on Jesus - while having an AMAZING time!

Kids Rock Camp is hosted at **Emmanuel Convention Centre** in Lewisporte, NL. This campground offers hotel & bunk-style rooms, cafeteria service, and tons of outdoor space (including a playground, basketball court & field!)

## WHO CAN ATTEND?

Kids Rock Camp is split into **two age groups**.

Our first, two-day camp (**Tuesday, July 29 - Thursday, July 31**) will be for children entering **grades 4-6**. These children will register, attend with, and be chaperoned by a local church group.

Our second, two-day camp (**Friday, August 1-Sunday, August 3**) is for children entering **grades K-3**. These children will register, attend with, and be chaperoned by a parent/guardian. Younger or older siblings are welcome to attend this camp with their families, but must pay the registration fee.

If you have a child with pervasive or needs, we would love for you (parent/guardian) to attend the August 1-3 camp with them.

## WHAT WILL IT COST ME?

Our first camp (grades 4-6) will cost \$160/camper. This cost includes:

- 2 nights of accommodations
- 6 meals (plus snacks!)
- All camp activities
- 3 kid-centered church services (with fantastic guests!)
- Amazing prizes & giveaways

Our second camp (grades K-3) will range in cost from \$120-200/person. Both parents/guardians and children will have to pay. The cost will depend on **how many people stay in your room as well as the room type you choose**. Younger siblings can attend (under 2 will be free, 2+ will have to pay) This cost includes:

- 2 nights of accommodations
- 6 meals (plus snacks and coffee...for parents of course!)
- All camp activities
- 3 family-focused church services (with fantastic guests)
- Amazing prizes & giveaways

Room options include **hotel or motel rooms or bunkhouse rooms** (with shared washrooms). If you have a camper, **you are also welcome to join us in the RV park**.

A **day-camp** registration option is available for the **second camp only at a cost of \$106/person**. This includes meals and all activities for the entire

camp - but no accommodations. Please see the online **registration form** for all details.

## WHAT DO WE DO AT KRC?

Great question! Kids Rock Camp is a jam-packed 3 days (2 nights) experience. Campers arrive at ECC mid-afternoon on the first day of camp.

**Day 1** starts with a delicious supper meal, followed by an amazing church service. There will be games to start, a kid-focused worship time, and a Bible teaching geared to that age group. Following the service, there will be a bedtime snack and activity.

**Day 2** starts with breakfast, followed by a full day of activities! Campers will participate in a host of different activities throughout the day including:

- A brief morning devotional
- Arts & crafts
- Group games
- Outdoor games & challenges
- Free play time at the playground and fields

We will have an afternoon church service geared specifically for children. Then we finish out the day with supper and a KRC Celebration Bash! Expect sweet treats, fun activities, and even a few surprises!

Our final day starts with room clean-up and breakfast. Before everyone heads home, we'll have one last church celebration! Kids will eat lunch and then hit the road.

## WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

If your child is attending **camp on their own**, here's what they'll need:

- Comfy outdoor shoes/sandals
- Clothing for 3 days (Don't forget clothes you can get messy!)
- Sleeping bag & pillow
- Towel, facecloth & toiletries
- Sunscreen & hat
- Extra snacks (peanut-free)
- Any medications they take (with signed instructions!)
- Bible

If your child is bringing a **device** (tablet or smartphone), it will only be permitted **in their room - not at services or activities**. Wi-fi **will not be accessible for campers**. Please speak to your pastor about your church's individual policy.

If your child is attending **camp with your family**, here's what everyone will need:

- Comfy outdoor shoes/sandals
- Clothing for 3 days (Don't forget clothes you can get messy!)
- Toiletries
- Extra towels for outdoor activities
- Sunscreen & hat
- Extra snacks (peanut-free please!)
- Any medications
- Bible

Please **be aware** that **Emmanuel Convention Centre** is an **alcohol and smoke-free facility**.

## WHAT ABOUT SPENDING MONEY?

All meals, accommodations and activities are included in the Kids Rock Camp registration fee.

We do take a special **Kids Missions Offering** for a special project (information below) - you can give using cash or debit.

We also have a small "**Kids Rock Camp Store**" that includes Kids Rock Camp merch and other small items children can buy.
