


President Cathy Polan's Remarks:

- July 2019 local real estate numbers show the month was quite active for our Professional Realtors[®] resulting in all numbers tracked by QDAR showing a positive result. This is something the records show hasn't occurred since December 2014, thus reflecting the strong local market.
- The monthly Dollar Sales for All Property Types in the Quinte area was \$131,594,845 reflecting a significant increase of 27.6% over 2018, which was \$103,131,458. The 2019 Year-to-Date figure also fared well, sitting at \$726,309,278 which is 9.8% over 2018.
- The July monthly Dollar Sales for Residential Listings also resulted in a substantial increase of 28.6% with \$125,972,445 for 2019 compared to \$97,978,178 for 2018. The 2019 Year-to-Date Residential number was \$668,318,921 resulting in a healthy 10.8% increase over the previous year.
- The Residential Average Sale Price for July continued the upward trend, once again showing an increase over 2018, with the 2019 price of \$367,267. The last time this monthly number did not increase year over year was in January 2016. The Year-to-Date Residential Average Sale Price also showed an increase of 8.9% over 2018.
- Residential Unit Sales for July 2019 resulted in 343 sales, also up from 286 sales for 2018. The Year-to-Date comparison shows 2019 is currently 1.8% above the 2018 sales.












Average Sale Price - Residential (within QDAR jurisdiction)





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
Number of Sales - All Property Types (includes outside QDAR jurisdiction)









Dollar Sales - All Property Types (includes outside QDAR jurisdiction)
