Registration	Registration from 8:15am. Archery GB membership cards to be shown.
Awards	Medals awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for single round and medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for double round. Junior archers wishing to compete for the senior awards must enter as a senior archer. Awards may change or not be presented depending upon the number of archers shooting in each category.
Entry Fees	£10.00 per session.
Times	Morning Session - assembly at 9am, sighters at 9:30am Lunch at 12pm Afternoon Session - assembly and sighters at 1pm, close at 3:30pm
Format	Portsmouth - Compound archers will shoot on a vertical 3-spot 60cm face Recurve, Barebow & Longbow archers will shoot on a 60cm face
Shooting Rules	This competition will be shot to Archery GB rules in force at the time of the event.
Smoking	Smoking of any sort is not permitted anywhere inside the building. <b>Entry to this competition constitutes acceptance of these terms.</b>
Refreshments and Raffle	Bacon rolls and Danish pastries available in the morning, and chilli and cob rolls plus a vegetarian option at lunchtime. Hot drinks, water, canned drinks, crisps and confectionery will be available throughout the day. Raffle tickets will be available all day with the draw following the afternoon session.
