



Hong Kong's changing healthcare market presents opportunity, but there are significant structural challenges that need consideration in new product design




- There has been a dramatic growth in the number of deaths attributable to dementia which is likely to be both a feature of ageing and enhanced recognition and diagnosis of the disease.
- Cancer, although the leading cause of death in Hong Kong, has seen very moderate growth in morbidity and mortality. This suggests that age-standardised incidence of cancer is likely to be stable or in decline, and treatments are more efficacious than in previous years.
- Considerable improvements are observable in mortality and morbidity from diabetes.
 his is likely to be the result of significant advinces in medical treatment, alongside earlier diagnosis and management.
 Together these factors mean that diabetes whilst a complicating and costly factor in treatment no longer holds a terminal prognosis.

Private health insurance is experiencing growth, but not in a profitable way. Profits have been shrinking for several years due to rising claims costs.



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
