

JUNIOR DRAGSTER (NHRA Safety and ET Rules Apply)

TWO STEPS AND EFI PROHIBITED

No Buy Backs In Jr dragster, FREE consolation race for anyone who lost in round 1 will be organized and run with the regular Jr rotation (Time and weather Permitting)

Class will be laddered in round 1 based on sportsman style ladder from best reaction time of the 2 time trials.

Ladder Lane Choice to better Qualifer. Qualifier will follow through all rounds.

Car's cannot dial faster then the limit of the competitors license

Tire Wraps must be removed in staging lanes before starting car

By pre staging, you have accepted the conditions of the race and all Dial Ins (Check Dial in boards). If you are in anyway unsure about Dial in, please verify it with the Starter/Tower.

No Re-Runs for incorrect Dial ins. NO EXCEPTIONS

NHRA Pull back rules apply to all Jr Dragster RCSS Races

Parent/Crew cannot adjust anything on car after pre stage light has been lit.

If after a round, a car was determined to be dialed to fast based on drivers age/license limitations, and that car wins the round, the win shall stand, however next round it MUST be dialed within the limitations. A second infraction of this rule within a season will be grounds for disqualification for that team.

On track rulings made my the Official starter or the Track provided Race Director are considered FINAL and will not be overturned by a RCSS official

Qualifying points as follows #1 = 16 points #2= 15 #3=14 #4=13 #5=12
#6=11 #7=10 #8=9 #9=8 #10-12=7 #13-14=6 #15-16=5

Consi winner will receive 100 Points.

Age requirements: Drivers may enter the NHRA Summit Racing Jr. Drag Racing League on the day of their 5th birthday in the noncompetitive Trainee category. Drivers may compete in the Jr. Drag Racing League from the day of their 6th birthday through the year of their 18th birthday.

TRAINEE: age 5; elapsed time restricted to 20.00 seconds or slower

YOUTH: ages 6 and 7; dial-in restricted to 13.90 seconds or slower

NOVICE: ages 8 and 9; dial-in restricted to 11.90 seconds or slower

INTERMEDIATE: ages 10 to 12; dial-in restricted to 8.90 sec or slower

ADVANCED: ages 13 to 18; dial-in restricted to 7.90 seconds or slower
