

STAGING

- Driving past the starting line after your burnout is prohibited. Do your burnout then proceed to stage. Only exception is cars with no front brakes. (Quick Sportsman Class Excluded)
- Courtesy staging will be in effect for all classes (except Jr Dragster), by pre-staging, you have accepted the conditions of the race. (Double check dial in board)
- Once one car has lit the pre-stage bulb, both cars can only move in a forward motion. Only exception is by the starters discretion.
- All drivers to proceed to stage in a timely manner. This rule will be strictly enforced by Track and or RCSS officials.
- Auto-start to be used.

BREAK POLICY

- Full refund for any racer who breaks before Round 1 in **non qualifying class**. Any racer which race vehicle breaks before Round 1 must come to the RCSS support Trailer and inform us before their Round 1 is called to the lanes. Failure to do so will result in the racer receiving no refund of their tech card money.

RAIN OUT POLICY

- In the event of rain-out or curfew, if a class has completed its first round of eliminations the race will be considered complete and the purse split among round winners. If a class has not started nor completed its first round, tech card money will be refunded 100%. If a class cannot complete the current round of competition, payouts will be split and based on previously completed round.

NHRA safety rules apply. Race will be run under NHRA procedures unless otherwise stated below. Any on track disputes are left to the discretion of Track and or RCSS officials.
