****** NOTICE TO BOTH PARTIES ******

Modification, extension, or dismissal of this protective order DOES NOT change any other court order. For example, it does NOT change any "no contact" condition issued in a criminal case.

During this protective order, both petitioner and respondent must give the court your current contact information (address and phone) so the court can notify you if there is any further action in this case (ask for confidentiality if necessary). You must also tell the court of any pending civil or criminal cases involving either party while this order is in effect.

Upon request, the court can extend the long-term protective order for one year if it is necessary to protect the petitioner. The petitioner may request additional extensions each following year.
