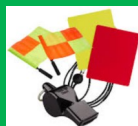

FA Veterans' John Waterfall Memorial Match

Today we ask everybody attending our event to take the opportunity to remember and celebrate the life of John Waterfall, Lee's Father who passed away recently.

John, born in June 1950, another Wolverhampton Wanderers fan and avid drummer, left us on 26th October after a brave three year fight against Cancer.

Father to Lee and Sarah, who with their respective spouses provided him with 5 grandchildren, Lee's three boys, Jacob, Joshua and Raiffe along with Sarah's Minnie and Nia. Sure John would have been proud of all five and especially happy to see Jacob and Josh embarking on football careers associated with the two senior West Midlands clubs.

Lilleshall National Sports Centre

Lilleshall Hall is a large former country house and estate (30,000 acres (120 km²)) in the fields of Shropshire. Owned by Sport England.

The sports centre was opened in 1951 by Queen Elizabeth II (then the Princess Elizabeth).

The 1966 England team trained for two weeks prior to their success in World Cup of 1966

The Football Association's School of Excellence was established at Lilleshall in 1984 and closed in the summer of 1999

During the mid-1980s to mid-1990s the England Team often trained at the centre, however, today most Premier League football clubs have now established their own centres of excellence based on the Lillleshall model.
