The Gable Enders and

Founded in 1879 and currently playing in Scottish Division 1, the third tier of the Scottish pyramid.

Founded shortly after, Forfar became a club in 1885, after breaking away from the older club of Forfar Angus.

Montrose moved to Links Park in 1887, and continued playing at the same site to date. The ground has a capacity of 4,936, including 1,386 seats.

Forfar's Station Park ground was opened in 1888, and currently holds 6.777 with 739 seats

Montrose's highest League position was achieved in the 1975-76 season, when they finished 3rd in Division 1, they have reached the Quarter Finals of the Scottish Cup on four occasions, the last being the same season as their highest league position.

Forfar's best league position was finishing 14th in Division 1 in 1985-86, but have reached the Semi-Final of the Scottish Cup in 1981-82.

Both clubs have played in the Scottish first division in their history.

Both clubs list each other (and Brechin City, who some are attending Saturday afternoon) as their main local rivals.
