

The Seasiders and the Linnets

Although Aberystwyth Town FC was formed in 1884, the club probably existed in the 1870s in an earlier incarnation – the re-establishment of a "town" club is recorded in 1876.

Barry Town United's history dates back to 1892 when an association football team named Barry and Cadoxton District was formed in the area.

Runners-up 7 times in the Welsh League South Aberystwyth became founder members of the League of Wales in 1992 and achieved third in their first season.

Barry Town have won the Cymru Premier on 7 occasions; 1995/6 1996/7 1997/8 1998/99 (4 consecutive seasons) 2000/1 2001/2 and 2002/3.

Aberystwyth Town are one of only three teams that have taken part in each season of the Cymru Premier.

Barry have played in European competitions in 11 seasons. With notable ties against Dynamo Kiev (twice), Aberdeen and Porto.

Aberystwyth have only played in Europe on three occasions, however the first two appearances where in the 'Intertoto cup'.

Jenner Park has been the setting for the evolution of Barry's senior football club for more than 100 years.

Park Avenue, currently called Aberystwyth University Stadium for sponsorship purposes, has served as the home of Aberwystwyth Town since 1907.
