

Welcome to Scotland (Again) FA Veterans FC Statistics

The Diamonds and the Anvils

In their current form, Aidrieonians were founded in 2002, although originally in 1878.

Similarly Gretna were reformed in 2008, although originally in 1946.

The Diamonds have played at the Excelsior Stadium (or New Broomfield) since 1998, their previous home of Broomfield Park just across the road is now a Safeway.

The Lowland League Greta Fc team have played at Raydale Park since foundation, although played the 2007-8 season at Fir Park, Motherwell as Raydale did not meet SPL standards.

Ironically, for this weekend, Aidrieonians lost their application after their financial collapse applying as a new team for league status to Gretna in 2002

Upon their success on the back of this, Gretna went on to win promotion in 3 consecutive years winning Divisions, 3, 2 and 1 before tier own financial collapse whilst in the Premier.

In their new guise, Aidrieonians have won the 2nd Division and Scottish Challenge Cup, whilst previous entity won the 1st division 3 times, the Scottish Cup and the Challenge Cup 3 times.

From 1987 to 2002 Gretna played in the Northern Leagues of the English football pyramid, winning the 1st Division in both 1990/1 and 1991/2, and making appearances in the 1st round of the FA Cup twice.
