The Hoops and Marsh Lane

Founded in 1892, a year before their 'Oxford Rivals', United, but have always been known as Oxford, whilst United only adopted the City name in 1960.

The Hoops won the FA Amateur cup in !906 and have won the Oxfordshire Senior Cup on 36 occasions.

The club fell behind it's rivals after United turned professional and City had some horrendous following years as a club, including having to resign from the Isthmian League in 1988 after landlords sold off their original White House ground. For housing

They were reformed two years later and joined the South Midlands League and winning its way back to the Isthmian league in 1993 when they also moved to the current home of Marsh Lane.

During the following years, the Hoops appeared in the final of the FA Vase in 1995 and, later, in the last season of the century, they took Wycombe Wanderers to three games in the FA Cup 1st Round, meaning City hold the record for the last tie to go to two replays, along with their record of 6 games against Alvechurch in 1971, neither will now be beaten due to rule changes.

With Hoops in the National League this season, it's the highest level they have ever appeared.

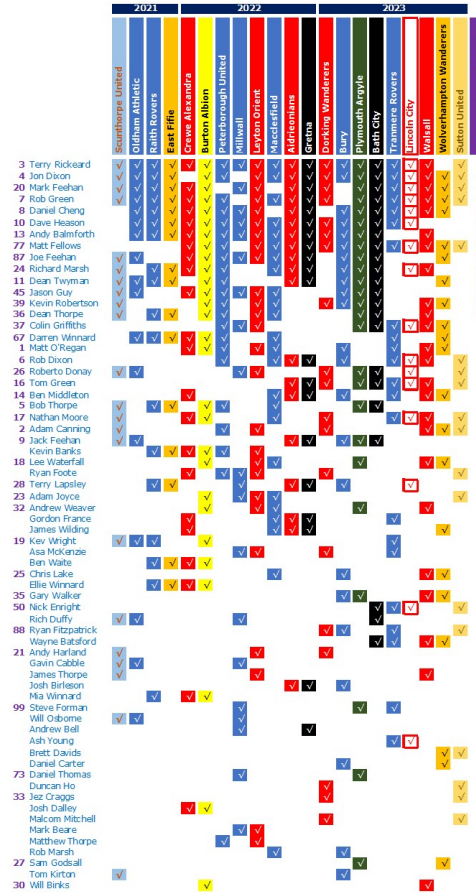
