The Wolves and Molineux

Formed as St. Luke's F.C. in 1877, the club changed name to Wolverhampton Wanderers two years later and became one of the founding members of the Football League in 1888.

In the summer of 1889 the club moved to its permanent home ever since, Molineux.

After becoming one of the first British clubs to install floodlights at its home ground in 1953, Wolves arranged televised "floodlit friendlies" against leading overseas club sides between 1953 and 1956, which were instrumental in the launch of the European Cup (now known as the UEFA Champions League) in 1955.


In the days before seating regulations, the ground could hold more than 60,000 spectators, with the record attendance being 61,315 for a First Division match against Liverpool on 11 February 1939.

Wolves have been champions of all four tiers of the English League: Tier One (3), Tier Two (4), Tier Three (3) and Tier four (1), also winning the FA Cup on 4 occasions, the League cup twice and the Charity Shield 4 times, along with the Football League Trophy, Football League War Cup and the Texaco Cup.
