




## Performance Details

#### Special Daddy Daughter Dance

Q - If my child is in two classes do I pay \$99 for each class?

A – Yes, but you will receive 2 costumes. Costumes typically run us about \$65 – \$75 so there isn't much room there for anything else to cover the costs of staff and videographer. Children enrolled in a combo class however, will learn two dances and will receive a 2-in-1 costume. Shown below. Tutu removes and fringe skirt is added taking a ballet costume to a jazz/tap costume! If your child takes a combo class and a hip-hop class or lyrical class, then that is considered separate classes and the fee applies twice.

Q - Can I just have my child perform in one class?

A - Yes, they will still learn the choreography in the other classes though, which is beneficial to them. Learning choreography teaches memorization skills and builds

teamwork, but yes, you can have your child participate in just one.

Q - What do they wear for Daddy/Daughter?

A - Any red dress they have at home. Choreography will be taught in studio.

Q - Is there an extra fee for Daddy/Daughter?

A - Yes, we're determining that now

Q - My child is currently taking class remotely. Does she need to attend an in-person class to participate?

A - No, she will still learn the choreography!

Q - When is the show?

A - We are planning our event for Saturday, December 5th from 12:30 - 3:30 and will run it similar to our July recital.
