General Public Comment

Every City Council meeting

Comments on motions, resolutions, and ordinances on that meeting's agenda

Community Forum
Council Meetings on 2nd and 4th
Tuesdays of the month
Comments on items over which
the Council has jurisdiction

Public Hearing
One-off, dedicated to a specific topic ie budget proposal or major upcoming Council decision

For all three opportunities, comment can be made in Chambers or via Zoom

This program takes place at night on a floating dock without railings.


