Linda Disosway, a new member, has been juried into Art Mart at The Bath House (2024 Art Mart, 521 E. Lawther Drive, Dallas).




I also won 3rd place at the State Fair of Texas in the Seascape category and also received honorable mention in the Abstract "Any" category for my botanical gradient painting.






Chuck Hendrickson


Tina has her photograph, "Zoom Zoom" exhibited with other artists at Flower Mound Library through mid-December.
