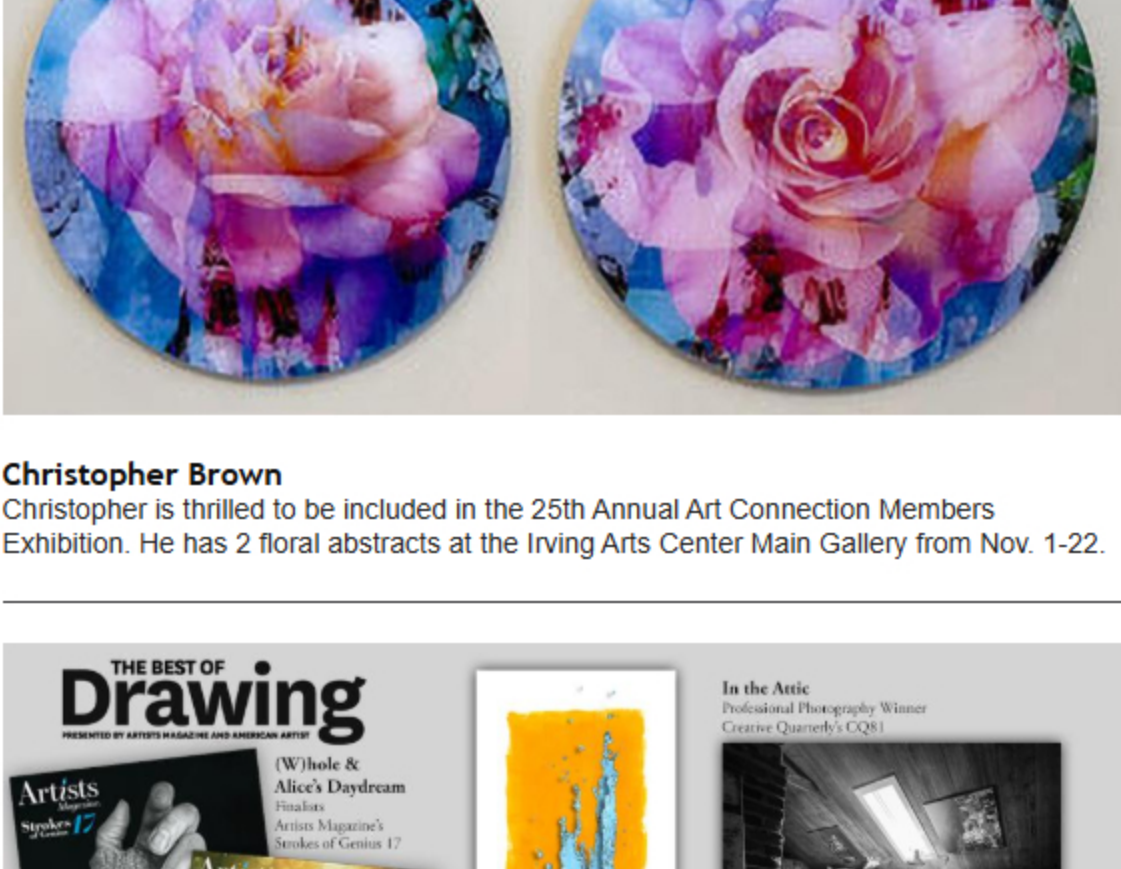
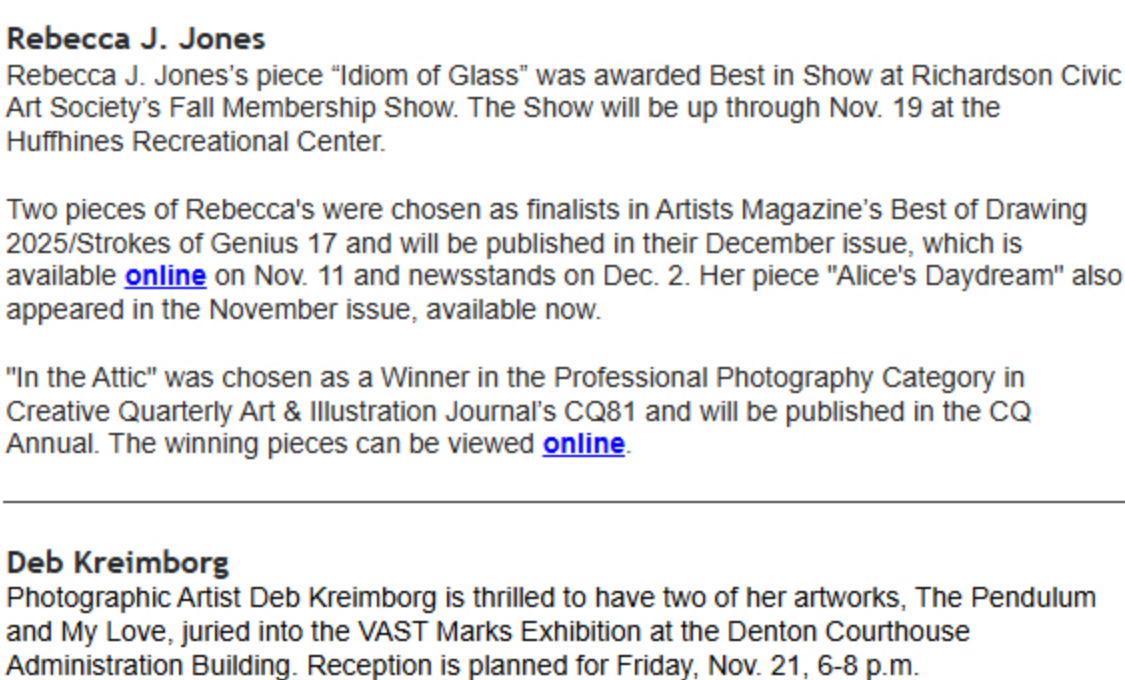

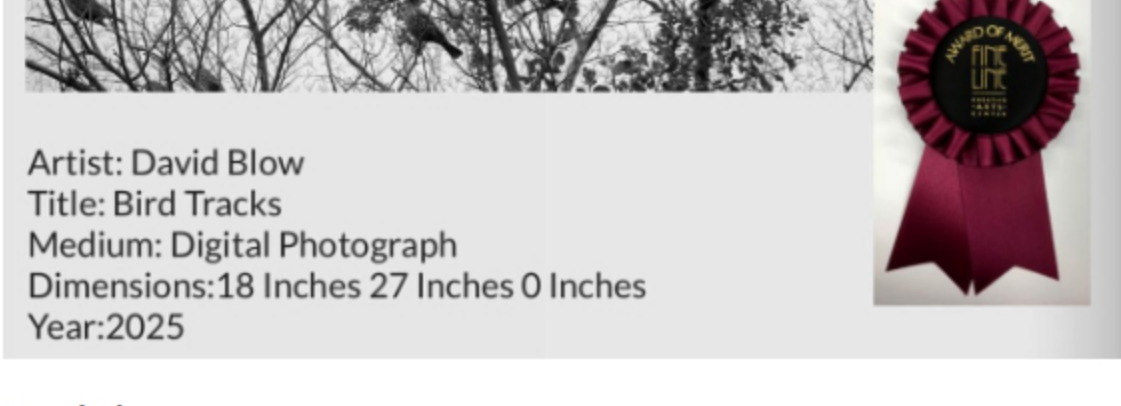

Deb Kreimborg

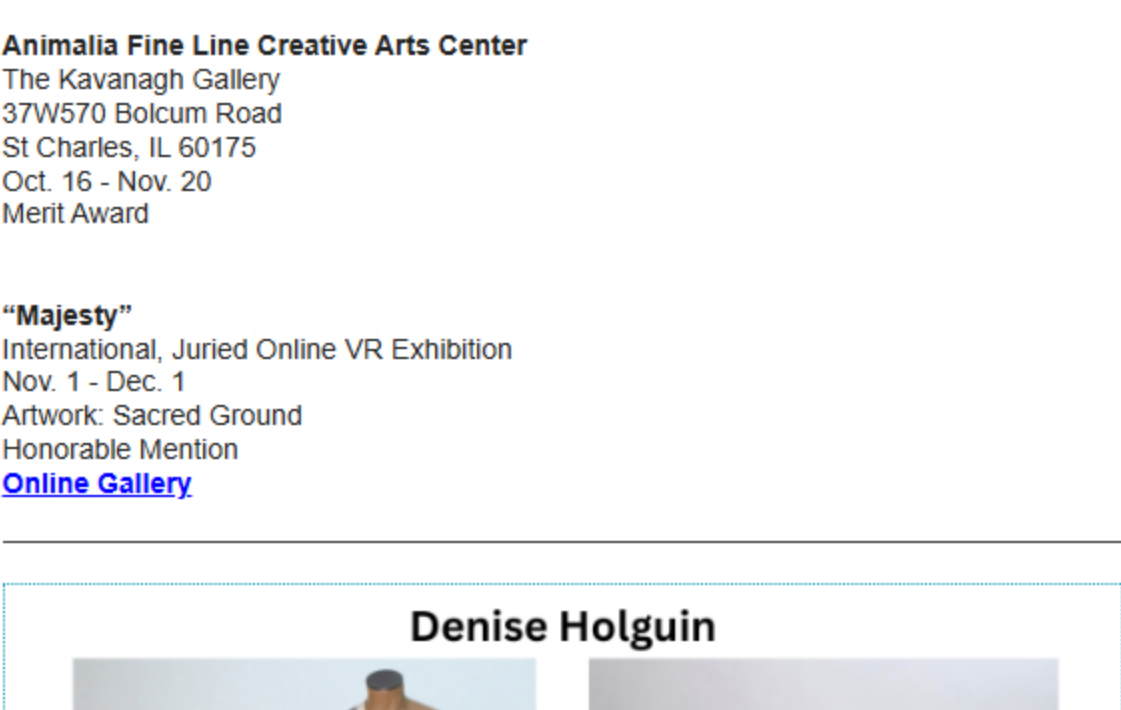

The insert photo "Last One Out" taken in 1975 by JJ Valdez of Leatherneck Magazine.

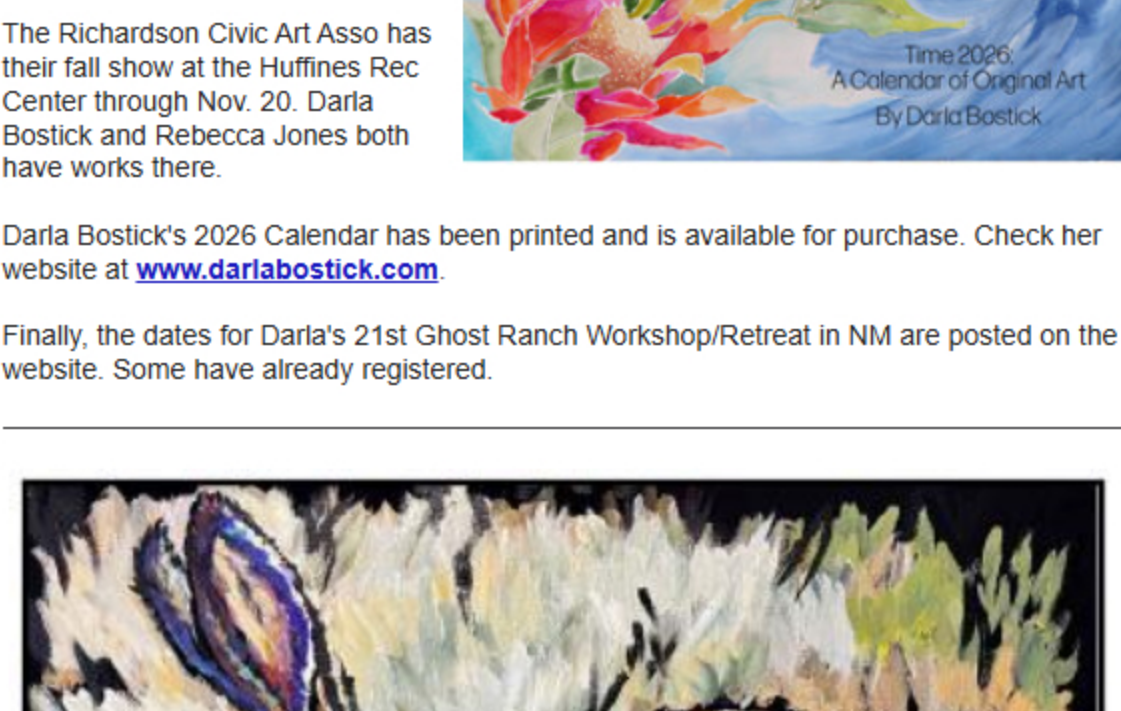
shows the back story of my set of photos.

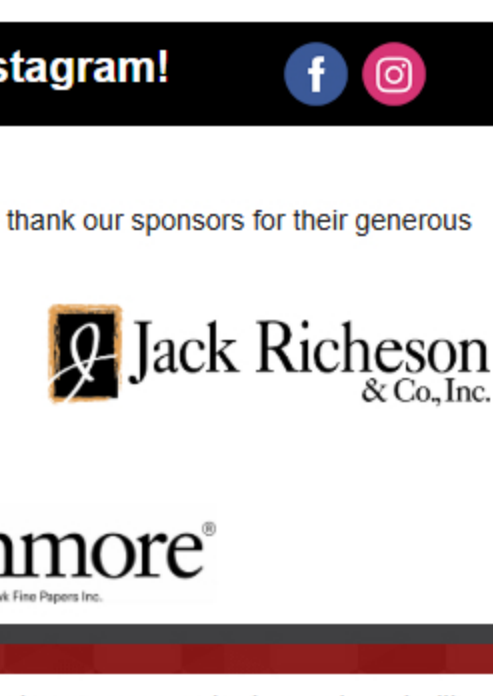
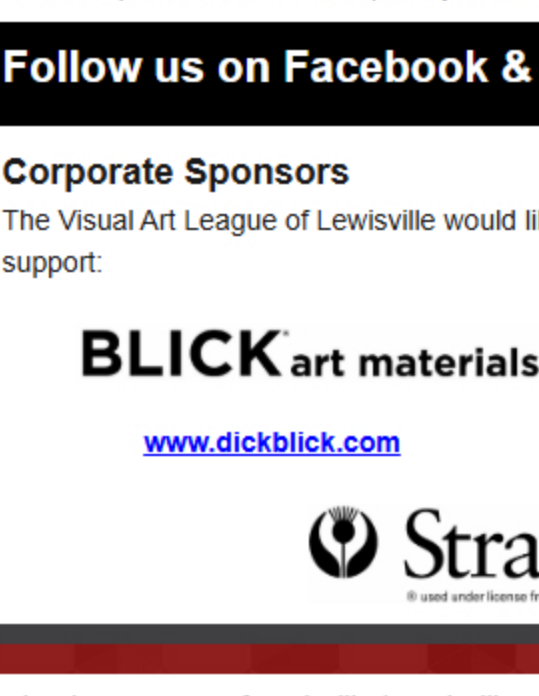
