- 1. All entries for HOME should be submitted to <u>vjcorwin@gmail.com</u> in the Subject line please put Home Submission.
- 2. This is a member only show. Entering artists must be members of VAL.
- 3. All media accepted.
- 4. No nudity or images of an inappropriate nature will be accepted. Remember this is a family friendly show.
- 5. Exhibit entries may not have been exhibited in a VAL show previously.
- 6. Only original art created within the last 24 months will be accepted. All art work submitted may not have been created in an instructional setting, included by not limited to workshops and art classes.
- 7. Entries must conform to Updated VAL Hanging Guidelines (pdf) at https://visualartleague.org/val-members-documents
- 8. All pieces to be hung on a wall must be properly wired for hanging with D rings and wire with ends covered so as not to injure any the of intake volunteers.
- 9. No sawtooth hangers or uniframes allowed.

- 10. Framed artwork larger than 16x20 must have acrylic glazing. NO GLASS, NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 11. **NO CLEAT** hangers! Acrylic artworks cannot have sharp edges. If they do, they must be framed.
- 12. Any special requirements for installation will be the responsibility of the artist, and they will install their own artwork.
- 13. VAL reserves the right to reject any works not meeting eligibility requirements or deemed inappropriate even after the image has been accepted.
- 14. Works no larger than 40" wide accepted to allow for maximum participation for VAL members. However, larger works accepted if space allows.
- 15. If your art sells during this show, it must remain at the Grand until strike date, June 10. A 20% commission is to be paid to VAL, half of which will go to the Lewisville Grand Theater.
- 16. Your art **MUST** be picked up on the strike dates as we no longer have a place to hold it. Please make arrangements with a friend to pick up your work for you if you are not able to do it yourself.
