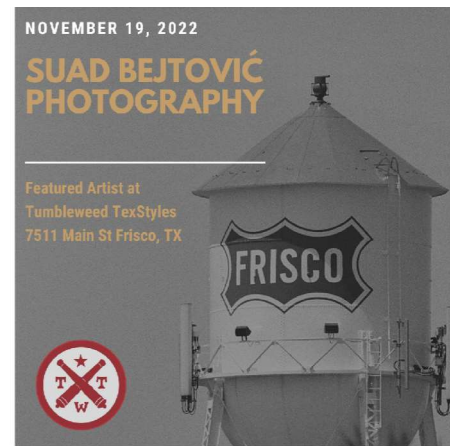
Jodie Beck

Lisa Chittenden

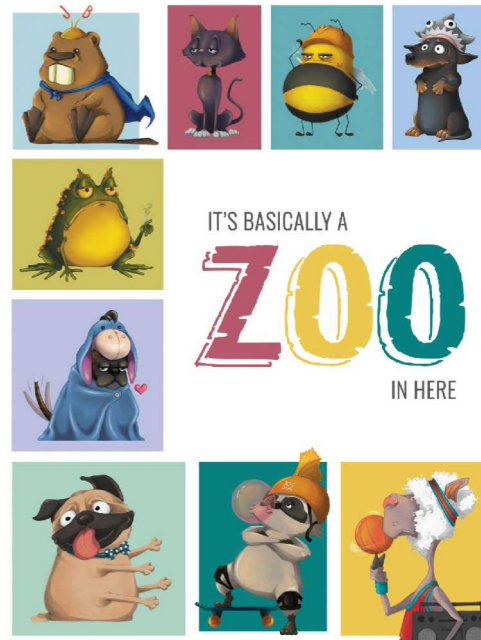
Come explore works by Visual Art League of Lewisville member, Lisa Chittenden, in the Administrative Hallway. Lisa is a mixed media artist who observes life in layers and expresses this through her art. At first, many of her compositions appear 2D, but as the viewer comes closer, they see her intricate collaging of 2D media with 3D elements, which raises the compositions off the substrate, adding depth and varying textures to her artworks. There is a distinct link between the found objects she incorporates with traditional media in each unique artwork. Her art illustrates this connectedness and creates new narratives for the viewer to experience.
