



## June Workshop - Acrylic Figure Painting


This workshop will be led by Adam Lancaster. Students will learn the fundamentals of painting with soft bodied acrylics, or what he considers "acrylic gouache." Students will use inexpensive and less intimidating materials that can be found at big box retailers like craft paint, canvas pads, and synthetic paint brushes and make use of items that can be found around the house like paper plates for palettes and plastic cups for holding water. The goal is to make painting approachable and enjoyable, and with the easy techniques Adam will teach for layering, brush control, and color mixing, students can be painting realistic figures by the end of the session.
