


# **Playing with Fun Patterns on Paper**

# Call for VAL Member Curator for Lewisville Playhouse Opportunity to expand your art career by curating art exhibitions.


This is a great opportunity to learn about the process of curating art exhibits and add the title of *curator* to your business card. The basic requirements besides the love for the arts are:
