- 2. Registered Forester with Michigan Department of Natural Resources
- 3. Technical Service Provider for CAP 106 Forest Management Plan
- 4. Technical Service Provider for CAP 142 Fish & Wildlife Habitat Plan
- 5. Forest Stewardship Program plan writer
- 6. Association of Consulting Foresters member
- 7. Other individual recognized by MDARD to write forest management plans
